AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE AUDITOR GENERAL TO RECEIVE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION AND ADDITIONAL COMMUTABLE TRANSPORTATION AND REPRESENTATION ALLOWANCES IN HIS CAPACITY AS *EX-OFFICIO* AUDITOR OF ALL GOVERNMENT-OWNED OR CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS AND OTHER SELF-GOVERNING BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND AGENCIES OF THE GOVERNMENT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES,
