**PROCLAMATION NO. 947**

**DECLARING MONDAY, DECEMBER 19, 2005 AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE CITY OF TUGUEGARAO**

**WHEREAS**, Sunday, December 18, 2005, marks the 6<sup>th</sup> Charter Day Anniversary of the City of Tuguegarao;

**WHEREAS**, to enable the people of the City of Tuguegarao celebrate the occasion, the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tuguegarao requested that Monday, December 19, 2005 be declared as special (non-working) day instead of December 18, 2005, which falls on a Sunday;
