AMENDMENT BY SUBSTITUTION

Introduced by Senator Lina, Jr.

AMENDING SECTION FORTY-TWO OF BATAS PAMBANSA BLG. 337, THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, BY REDUCING THE MINIMUM AGE OF THE DIFFERENT ELECTIVE LOCAL OFFICIALS MENTIONED THEREIN

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 42 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 337 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 42. Qualifications. - (1) An elective local official must be a citizen of the Philippines, _ at least twenty-three years of age on election day _ a qualified voter registered as such in the barangay, municipality, city or province where he proposes to be elected, a resident therein for at least one year at the time of the filing of his certificate of candidacy, able to read and write English, FILIPINO _ Pilipino _ 7, or any other local language or dialect.

"(2) CANDIDATES FOR THE POSITIONS OF GOVERNOR, VICE-GOVERNOR, OR MEMBER OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN MUST BE AT LEAST TWENTY-THREE YEARS OF AGE ON ELECTION DAY.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Article II Section 13 of the Constitution provides that The State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs.

Considering that the youth constitutes 67.8% of the national population (39 million out of the 57 million estimated population as of December 1986) it is the obligation of the national leadership to give them wider participation in the policy and decision making process in government.

This Bill hopes to partially fullfill this obligation and strenghten the faith of the youth in government by allowing them to participate in the different levels of government administration.
