AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE TIBUNGCO
ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN DAVAO CITY TO FRAN-
CISCO BUSTAMANTE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives
of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. The Tibungco Elementary School in Davao City shall be known as the Francisco Bustamante Elementary School.


SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
