I. No. 5076 - An Act to provide the general basic coeoperative law and to consolidate and amend existing laws on non-agricultural co-operatives in the Philippines with special provisions for given types of co-operatives.

Introduced by Congressmen Tolentino, Duran, Roy and others:

Submitted to the Senate on May 17, 1957;

Referred to the Committee on Commerce and Industry on the same day;

Certified for immediate enactment by the President of the Philippines on May 10, 1957;

The Senate having passed a Mill (S.No.237) similar to this Mill, and owing to discrepancies found in the provisions of the two measures, the Senate asked for a conference on May 17, 1957, having designated as representatives on its part Senators Cea, Delgado and Rodrigo;

The House insisted on its fill and accepted the conferees asked for by the Senate on May 21, 1957, having appointed as conferees at the same on its part Congressmen Burano, Enverga and Macapa-

Conference Report was submitted with the statement that the Conference Committee has reached an agreement on the disagreeing votes of both Houses, and agreed to by the Senate on May 23, 1957;

The House approved the Report of the Conference Committee on May 23, 1957;

Approved by the President of the Philippines on June 22, 1957;

Converted into Republic Act No. 223.

- An Act to promote schentific, engineering and technological research, invention and development.

Introduced by the Committee on Education, as per Committee Report No. 2604, with Congressmen Laurel, Mayoos, Abad, Denito and Ramos as co-authors;

Submitted to the Senate on May 17, 1956;

Referred to the Committee on Scientific Development on the same day;

The Senate having passed a Bill (S.No.507) similar to this Bill, and owing to discrepancies found in the provisions of the two measures, the Sanate asked for a conference on June 27, 1956, having designated as representatives on its part Senators Iocsin, Pelaez and Paredes;

The House insisted on its fill and accepted the conference asked for by the Senate on July 2, 1956, having appointed as conferees at the same on its part Congresswoman Consing, Congressmen Lim and Ziga;
