RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING FILIPINO KICKBOXING CHAMPION STEVE "THE RED KNIGHT" GRANDEZA FOR EMERGING VICTORIOUS AT THE K1 WORLD KICKBOXING FEDERATION SUPER WELTERWEIGHT CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD IN DUBAI, UNITED ARAB EMIRATES ON 1 OCTOBER 2010

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has in several occasions paid tribute to exemplary Filipinos for their contribution in bringing home pride and honor to the country by winning in international competitions;

WHEREAS, Filipino Kickboxing Champion Steve "The Red Knight" Grandeza made the country proud by bringing home the Super Welterweight Title at the K1 World Kickboxing Federation Championships held at the Chi Garden, The Lodge, Dubai in the United Arab Emirates last 1 October 2010;

WHEREAS, the World Kickboxing Federation is recognized worldwide as a regulating governing body for professional kickboxing and is one of the leading organizations in the promotion of professional kickboxing in all styles, Muay Thai and Mixed martial arts hosting professional fighting events;

WHEREAS, Steve "The Red Knight" Grandeza defeated his rival Al Hassan "The Ghanian Van Damme" Okine via a unanimous decision after seven rounds of their World Super Welterweight Championship fight;

WHEREAS, Steve Grandeza is the first Filipino to win a professional kickboxing title;

WHEREAS, Steve Grandeza is also the reigning champion of Ultimate Striker Muay Thai 3, 4 and 5;

WHEREAS, the outstanding performance by our Filipino athletes deserve to be commended for the honor and recognition they have brought to our country;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to congratulate and commend Filipino Kickboxing Champion Steve "The Red Knight" Grandeza for emerging victorious at the K1 World Kickboxing Federation Super Welterweight Championships held in Dubai, United Arab Emirates on 1 October 2010.
