

RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON FINANCE AND THE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC EXPENDITURES TO INQUIRE ON THE STATUS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT, FY 2011, RELATIVE TO THE "PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM"

WHEREAS, on December 2010, Republic Act No. 10147 was passed for the appropriations of funds for the operation of the government of the Republic of the Philippines and its programs, including the "Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program."

WHEREAS, under XX.B.I.a. of R.A. No. 10147, the amount of PhP21,194,117,000.00 was appropriated for the implementation of the "Conditional Cash Transfer Program" (CCT) as part of the "Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program" (4Ps).

WHEREAS, this fund shall be used in accordance with the 4Ps Operations Manual issued by the DSWD in order to address poverty reduction and social development strategy of the national government.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and the Oversight Committee on Public Expenditures in the Senate and the House of Representatives is mandated to strictly monitor the effective implementation of the CCT.

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the Congress to scrutinize the utilization of the budget dedicated for the implementation of the "Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to direct the Senate Committee on Finance and the Oversight Committee on Public Expenditure to look into the status of the implementation of R.A. No. 10147 relative to the "Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program".
