**RESOLUTION**  
**COMMENDING THE DELEGATION WHICH REPRESENTED THE**  
**PHILIPPINES IN THE RECENTLY CONCLUDED WIZARDS AT MATHEMATICS**  
**INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION (WIZMIC) HELD IN LUCKNOW, INDIA ON**  
**OCTOBER 21-24, 2011.**

**WHEREAS**, on October 21-24, 2011, the Philippines participated in the Wizards at Mathematics International Competition in Lucknow, India;

**WHEREAS**, the Wizards at Mathematics International Competition was organized by the City Montessori School in Lucknow, India with the support of the Lucknow government;

**WHEREAS**, Thirty-nine teams (39) from the nine (9) participating countries joined the contest;

**WHEREAS**, the nine (9) participating countries are China, Nepal, Thailand, Indonesia, Bangladesh, South Africa, Sri Lanka, host India, and the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, the Philippines was represented by a team trained by the Mathematics Trainers Guild Philippines (MTG) composed of students from various schools in the country;

**WHEREAS**, in the Individual contest, the Filipino students bagged six gold, four silver, and four bronze medals;

**WHEREAS**, the Filipino gold medalists are Jasper John Segismundo of Pasig Catholic College, Miko Johnson Ong Co of St Stephen's High School, Cary Albert Chan of St. Jude Catholic School, Raphael Villaluz of San Beda College-Alabang, Xavier Jefferson Ray Go and Gene Go, Jr. of Zamboanga Chong Hua High School;

**WHEREAS**, the Filipino silver medalists are Ezzekiell Young of Jubilee Christian Academy, Mikhaela Marie Diaz of Special Education Center for the Gifted, Cristiana Marie Calderon of Falcon Learning Center, and Terence Brian Tsai of Chiang Kai Shek College;

**WHEREAS**, the Filipino bronze medalists are Andrew Vince Lee of Xavier School, Angelika Joie Tagupa of Colegio San Agustin-Makati, Anica Clarice Antonella Galano of St. Paul College-Pasig, and Lou Irish Gonzales of Pasig Catholic School;


**WHEREAS**, in the team contest, Philippines Team B won first place and Philippines Teams C and D won second place and Philippines Team A won third place;

**WHEREAS**, in the overall ranking, the Philippines Team B placed second among the Thirty-nine (39) participating teams,
