

RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE PHILIPPINE SEPAK TAKRAW TEAM FOR WINNING THE GOLD MEDAL IN THE MEN'S DOUBLES DIVISION IN THE RECENTLY CONCLUDED 27TH KING'S CUP TAKRAW WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP HELD IN BANGKOK, THAILAND LAST JULY 2-6, 2012

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has, in numerous occasions, acknowledged outstanding Filipino athletes for their astounding accomplishments of bringing home pride and glory by winning in international sporting competitions;

WHEREAS, the team of Filipino sepak takraw players composed of Rheyjey Ortouste, Johnjohn Bobier, and Arnel Isorena won gold in the men's doubles division of the 27th King's Cup World Championships in Bangkok, Thailand;
