WHEREAS, among his best works are the Sandugo Shrine in his hometown in Tagbliaran, Bohol, the Transfiguration at the Eternal Garden Memorial Park, the Nine Muses at the UP Faculty Center, the Sunburst at the Peninsula Manila Hotel, the Bronze figure of Teodoro M. Kalaw in front of the National Library, Murals in Marble at the National Heroes Shrine, Mt. Samat, Bataan, the Fourteen Stations of the Cross at EDSA Shrine, Fredesvinda in Fort Canning, Singapore, and The Sculpture at the

United Nations headquarters in New York City;
