

## INTRODUCED BY SENATOR ANA THERESIA "RISA" HONTIVEROS - BARAQUEL

## A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SENSE OF THE SENATE TO DECLARE MARCH 18- 24, 2018 AS 'BANGSAMORO SOLIDARITY WEEK'

- 3 WHEREAS, Our 1987 Constitution renounces war as an instrument of national policy,
- 4 adopts the generally accepted principles of international law as part of the law of the land
- and adheres to the policy of peace, equality, justice, freedom, cooperation, and amity with
- 6 all nations. (Article II, Section 2);
- 7 WHEREAS, The Constitution clearly advocates for the maintenance of peace and order, the
- 8 protection of life, liberty, and property, and promotion of the general welfare as essential
- 9 for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy. (Article II, Section 5);
- 10 WHEREAS, The Constitution mandates the creation of an autonomous region in Muslim
- 11 Mindanao and calls for the enactment of an organic act for the autonomous region;
- 12 WHEREAS, In the quest for a just and lasting peace in Mindanao, the Government of the
- 13 Philippines (GPH) and the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) signed a Comprehensive
- Agreement on the Bangsamoro (CAB) on March 27, 2014;
- 15 WHEREAS, The gains of almost two decades of peace process and negotiations between the
- 16 GRP/GPH and MILF must be realized as part of the national agenda for peace and social
- 17 justice;

- 18 WHEREAS, The Bangsamoro Basic Law (BBL), a legal instrument reflecting the CAB, its
- 19 annexes, and in essence, and all prior peace agreements aiming at correcting historical
- 20 injustice is on its way to becoming a law;
- 21 WHEREAS, The Marawi incident last year, which has unfortunately resulted to the brutal
- demise and displacement of thousands of innocent civilians, has grave implications to the
- 23 continuing peace process;

- 1 WHEREAS, Civil society, the broad peace movements, and the peoples of Mindanao remain
- 2 steadfast with their commitment to the peace process and thus express their full support to
- 3 the immediate enactment of an inclusive Bangsamoro law that ensures delivery of
- 4 significant peace and social justice measures to end the decades of conflict in Mindanao and
- 5 address the historical injustices committed against the Bangsamoro and all other
- 6 inhabitants of Mindanao;
- 7 WHEREAS, In the spirit of solidarity and peace, members of civil society, the broad peace
- 8 movements and the peoples of Mindanao, under the banners of All-Out Peace (AOP)
- 9 movement, Mindanao Peaceweavers (MPW) and Initiatives for International Dialogue (IID),
- 10 fully support all meaningful solutions to achieve a lasting peace and social justice for
- Mindanao and any measure that seeks to provide greater autonomy for the Bangsamoro as
- mandated by the 1987 Philippine Constitution;
- 13 WHEREAS, Significant historical events in the Bangsamoro include: the signing of the
- 14 Comprehensive Agreement on the Bangsamoro on 27th of March 2014; commemoration of
- the historic 'Jabidah Massacre' which took place on 18th of March 1968; the Bud Dajo
- Massacre on 6th of March 1906; the 'Dansalan Declaration' on 18th of March 1935; the celebration
- of the Bangsamoro Week of Peace which started on 12th of March; and the entire month of
- 18 March as Women's Herstory Month honoring the courageous women of Mindanao and the
- 19 whole country;
- 20 WHEREAS, Civil society formations together with their broad constituency and partners in
- 21 the Bangsamoro and the entire country have decided to issue a "People's Declaration for A
- Day of Solidarity for the Bangsamoro" on March 18, 2018 in recognition of the just struggle
- 23 of the Bangsamoro people for self-determination;
- 24 WHEREAS, In recognition of the gains and integrity of the peace process and the historical
- events that shaped the Bangsamoro struggle, a solidarity week is set to commemorate
- 26 peace and justice in the Bangsamoro and the entire country;
- 27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Senate of the
- 28 Philippines, in the spirit of staying the course for genuine peace, support to the peace
- 29 process and standing in full solidarity with the Bangsamoro, to support and declare
- 30 henceforth March 18-24 2018, as the 'BANGSAMORO SOLIDARITY WEEK'.
