RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEES TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE UTILIZATION OF INLAND WATERWAY TRANSPORT AND THE REHABILITATION OF THE PASIG RIVER FERRY SERVICE

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 9 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides the State shall promote a just and dynamic social order that will ensure the prosperity and independence of the nation and free the people from poverty through policies that provide adequate social services, promote full employment, a rising standard of living, and an improved quality of life for all;

WHEREAS, the Asian Development Bank (ADB) defines inland waterway transport (IWT) is a low-cost, environmentally friendly way of transporting people and goods that utilizes the potential of natural and man-made waterway networks;

WHEREAS, the Pasig River Ferry Service, which started operations on February 14, 2007. It is the longest serving ferry in the Pasig River with a route of twenty eight kilometers (28km) and two (2) lines;

WHEREAS, the Pasig River Ferry Service has a long history of pollution-related problems, odor and garbage problems, and the persistent infestation of water lilies blocking the pathway of boats and the stations that caused difficulties for previous ferry lines in the river to operate;

WHEREAS, the latest Pasig River Ferry Service, operated by Nautical Transport Services Incorporated, which was reactivated on April 28, 2014, is currently managed by the Metro Manila Development Authority (MMDA);

WHEREAS, an article from the Philippine Daily Inquirer, dated on April 4, 2018, reported that the government is seeking the privatization of the Pasig River Ferry Service which is up for rehabilitation;

WHEREAS, the article from the Philippine Daily Inquirer further reported on the rehabilitation of the Pasig River Ferry Service through the construction of twenty nine (29) additional stations to serve 76,000 commuters per day and the addition of twenty four (24) air conditioned boats with fifty (50) sitting capacity each which are to travel with a regular fifteen (15) minute interval;

WHEREAS, the article from the Philippine Daily Inquirer also reported that the current Pasig River Ferry Service run by the MMDA has twelve (12) stations, with the PUP Sta. Mesa and Sta. Ana stations currently undergoing repair and maintenance;

WHEREAS, an article from the Manila Standard, dated July 31, 2018, reported that the House of Representatives' Committee on Appropriations allotting two (2) billion pesos in the proposed General Appropriations Act of 2019 for the rehabilitation of the Pasig River Ferry Service;

WHEREAS, studies from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) show that transporting people and goods over inland waterways, such as rivers and canals, can decrease road traffic, accidents and pollution;

WHEREAS, the ADB highly recommends the utilization of inland waterway transport in addressing congestion and capacity problems in land-based transport systems;

WHEREAS, a Senate inquiry on the matter is necessary in order to establish an alternative mode of transportation that Metro Manila greatly needs given the current traffic congestion and railway situation for the purpose of providing the people adequate public transportation services;

BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to direct the proper Senate
Committees to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the utilization of inland
waterway transport and the rehabilitation of the Pasig River Ferry Service.
