RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEES TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE REPORT THAT MATERNAL HEALTHCARE REMAINS A CHALLENGE IN AREAS AFFECTED BY THE MARAWI SIEGE

WHEREAS, the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) reported that, providing maternal healthcare remains a challenge in areas affected by the Marawi siege¹;

WHEREAS, while the conflict eventually came to a halt last October, nearly 70,000 people remained displaced, living in evacuation centers, transitional sites and host communities²;

WHEREAS, cut off from medical care and exposed to trauma, malnutrition and violence, women in conflict settings face increased risks to their health and well-being – including risks due to overcrowding and other harmful conditions in centers³;

WHEREAS, one of the displaced women in Marawi told UNFP that it took a month before she learned that she was suffering from anemia due to $childbirth^4$

WHEREAS, to meet the needs of the roughly 2,000 displaced women and girls of reproductive age in and around Marawi, UNFPA is supporting 25 medical missions that provide reproductive health information and services⁵;

WHEREAS, in times of crisis, reproductive health services – including skilled birth attendance and emergency obstetric care – often become unavailable, leaving pregnant women vulnerable to life-threatening complications⁶;

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the government improve the pace of postconflict health interventions;

BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to direct the proper Senate Committees to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the report that maternal healthcare remains a challenge in areas affected by the Marawi siege.
