RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC ORDER AND DANGEROUS DRUGS TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, INTO THE ASSASSINATION OF AND ATTACKS AGAINST LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS WITH THE END IN VIEW OF CONDUCTING AN ASSESSMENT OF THE PEACE AND ORDER SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY AND AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 6975, AS AMENDED

- **WHEREAS**, it is stated in Article 2, Section 5 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution that "the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy;"
- WHEREAS, the Philippine National Police is mandated under Republic Act No. 6975, as amended, to "enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the protection of lives and properties; maintain peace and order and take all necessary steps to ensure public safety; investigate and prevent crimes, effect the arrest of criminal offenders and bring offenders to justice and assist their prosecution;"
- **WHEREAS**, in the last two (2) years, an alarming number of cases of killings of local government officials in various parts of the country has been observed;
- **WHEREAS**, in the past three months alone, it has been reported that two (2) mayors and two (2) vice mayors were shot by unidentified assassins;
- **WHEREAS**, on July 2, 2018, Mayor Antonio Halili of Tanauan City, Batangas was shot dead during the weekly flag raising ceremony in front of the city hall.

Mayor Halili was rushed to the hospital following the shooting but succumbed to the gunshot wound on his chest;

WHEREAS, on July 3, 2018, Mayor Ferdinand Bote of General Tinio, Nueva Ecija was killed in an ambush in Cabanatuan City. Mayor Bote was aboard a Toyota Fortuner when he was shot multiple times. He was rushed to MV Gallego Hospital but was declared dead on arrival;

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2018, Vice Mayor Alexander Lubigan of Trece Martires, Cavite was killed in an ambush when gunmen blocked the path of his black Toyota Hi-lux pickup truck and opened fire. Vice Mayor Lubigan was killed instantly while his driver-bodyguard succumbed to his wounds a few hours later at General Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital. His security aide survived and was being treated in the city's Korea-Philippines Friendship Hospital;

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2018, Vice Mayor Al-Rashid Mohammad Ali of Sapa-Sapa, Tawi-Tawi was shot dead in an ambush after a lone gunman approached the vice mayor's vehicle and fired four times at Vice Mayor Ali, who was seated in the front passenger side. The vice mayor was rushed to the hospital was declared dead on arrival;

WHEREAS, there have been other reports of local government officials being killed in the last two years namely:

- a) Vice Mayor Aaron Sampaga of Pamplona, Cagayan on August 5, 2016;
- b) Mayor Samsudin Dimaukom of Datu Saudi Ampatuan, Maguindanao on October 28, 2016;
- c) Mayor Rolando Espinosa of Albuera, Leyte on November 5, 2016;
- d) Vice Mayor Anwar Sindatuk of Datu Saudi Ampatuan, Maguindanao on November 27, 2016;
- e) Mayor Mohammad Limbona of Pantar, Lanao del Norte on December 30, 2016;
- f) Mayor Arsenio Agustin of Marcos, Ilocos Norte on June 3, 2017;
- g) Mayor Leovino Hidalgo of Balete, Batangas on June 10, 2017;
- h) Mayor Reynaldo Parojinog of Ozamiz, Misasmis Occidental on July 30, 2017;

| 9 | WHEREAS, the spate of killings of local government officials throughout the |
| 10 | country has caused grave concern, fear, insecurity, and distress in the general |
| 11 | populace, especially given that many of these killings have occurred in broad |
| 12 | daylight; |
| 13 | WHEREAS, the deadly attacks on local leaders underscore the growing |
| 14 | culture of impunity and escalating violence that threatens to permeate Philippine |
| 15 | society today; |
| 16 | WHEREAS, there is cause for more action to be done towards investigating |
| 17 | these killings so as to ensure the Fiiipino people that the State is still capable of |
| 18 | maintaining peace and order, protecting the lives of the people, and promoting the |
| 19 | general welfare of the nation; |
| 20 | WHEREAS, the DILG and the PNP have the duty to provide the public with |
| 21 | the true state of peace and order in the country: Now, therefore, be it |
| 22 | RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to direct the Committee on Public Order |
| 23 | and Dangerous Drugs to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, into the |
| 24 | assassination of and attacks against local government officials with the end in view |
| 25 | of conducting an assessment of the peace and order situation in the country and |
