RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND RECOGNIZING THE NATIONAL PARA BOWLING TEAM FOR THEIR SUCCESSFUL RUN IN THE 2022 ASIAN OPEN PARA BOWLING HELD ON NOVEMBER 27 TO DECEMBER 3, 2022 IN BANGKOK, THAILAND

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has, on several occasions, give recognition and commendation to outstanding Filipinos for their exceptional feats of bringing honor, pride and glory to the country by garnering prestigious awards;

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution states that "The State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry";

WHEREAS, the 2022 Asian Para Bowling Championship is a 2-in-1 competition event and is part of the World Para Bowling Tour. It is participated by all para bowling athletes from South Korea, Japan, Taiwan, Brunei, Singapore, India, Thailand and the Philippines. This year's edition marks the re-start of the Para Bowling events under WPB Tour since the pandemic;

WHEREAS, The Philippine para tenpin bowling athletes won five (5) medals - one silver and four medals - at the 2022 Asian Para Bowling Championships in Bangkok, Thailand, on November 27-December 3, 2022;

WHEREAS, Patrick Eusebio bagged silver medal in the All Events B10 category;

WHEREAS, Kim Ian Chi won bronze medal in single event B10 category;

WHEREAS, Angelito Guloya and Christopher Yue snatched bronze medal in the Double Event B9 + B9 category;

WHEREAS, Samuel Matias and Kim Ian Chi got bronze medal in Double Event B10 + B10 category;

WHEREAS, Francisco Ednaco, Angelito Guloya and Patrick Eusebio reaped bronze medal in the Trio Team Event Mixed B8 + B9 + B10 category;

WHEREAS, the success of the Filipino differently-abled bowlers in their international competitions have shown the nation's unrelenting spirit to persevere amidst adversity. Their exemplary performance, despite the challenge of their physical limitations, deserves commendation for bringing pride to the country for their strength and agility. They have inspired their fellow athletes to continue honing their skills in their respective sports;
