RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING SYDNEY SY TANCONTIAN FOR WINNING A GOLD MEDAL AT THE 2022 ASIAN SAMBO CHAMPIONSHIPS IN JOUNIEH, LEBANON

1 WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 19 of the Philippine Constitution mandates that "the State shall promote physical education and encourage 2 sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training 3 for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork and 4 excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry": 5 WHEREAS, 22-year old Davaoeña Sydney Sy Tancontian ruled the 6 women's 80kg sports sambo category and captured a gold medal in the 2022 7 Asian Sambo Championships at the Bouddha Sports Center in Jounieh, 8 Lebanon; 9 10 WHEREAS, Tancontian swiftly secured the championship title after edging out her close opponent Arailym Abenova of Kazakhstan, with a score 11 of 1-0 in the finals; 12 WHEREAS, her victory was a sweet comeback after she lost to the 13 same opponent in round 16 of the World Championship in Tashkent, 14 Uzbekistan; 15 WHEREAS, the Filipino sambist Tancontian's recent feat was her 16 second continental title after winning the Asian Junior gold medal in 2019 in 17 the same event in Mongolia: 18 19 WHEREAS, she is also a five-time World Sambo Championship bronze 20 winner, and an active athlete of sambo, kurash, and judo:

WHEREAS, Tancontian's achievements gave us national pride and honor, her grit and determination to succeed is an epitome of a true Filipino spirit and it will serve as a guiding motivation to our future Filipino athletes: Now, therefore, be it:
