RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Manny "PACMAN" Pacquiao has won a spectacular ninth round knockout against Mexican-American David Diaz during their bout dubbed as "Lethal Combination" in Mandalay Bay Resort and Casino, Las Vegas, Nevada, USA on June 28, 2008;
