RESOLUTION
COMMENDING GERALDINE BANIQUED, ANGELINE BANIQUED AND
STEPHANIE ANNE OLIVEROS FOR WINNING IN THE 7TH MATH OLYMPIAD
HELD IN CHINA

WHEREAS, three young Filipina math wizards bagged three medals in the 7th Math Olympiad held on 14-18 August 2008 in Zhongshan, China;

WHEREAS, the medal winners are Geraldine Baniqued, 15, a junior at St. Paul College-Pasig and Angeline Baniqued, an alumna of the same school and currently a freshman at the Ateneo de Manila University, won a bronze medal. The other bronze medalist was Stephanie Anne Oliveros, also a freshman at the Ateneo, who graduated last March from the Philippine Science High School;

WHEREAS, the six-member Philippine team competed with the best female math wizards from the different parts of China and the United States, which both fielded several teams, and Russia, Hong Kong and Macau;

WHEREAS, the competition was originally established as a regional competition for teams of female high school students from China and other eastern Asian countries (including Russia);

WHEREAS, the competition has now expanded to countries from around the world including participants from the USA, Canada, South Africa and Australia;

WHEREAS, our young students continue to show that Filipinos can also be excellent in Math like their counterparts in other countries and the three young Filipina winners have given honor, recognition and goodwill to our country;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE PHILIPPINES, to commend Geraldine Baniqued, Angeline Baniqued and Stephanie Anne Oliveros for winning in the 7th Math Olympiad held in China.
