RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND
COMMENDING FILIPINO BODYBUILDER
RENATO DIO FOR WINNING THE 2008
WORLD BODYBUILDING AND FITNESS
CHAMPIONSHIPS IN ATHENS, GREECE
