WHEREAS, the world's top-ranked billiards players from around the world competed in the inaugural Qatar International 9-Ball Open Billiards Championship, a competition organized and sponsored by the Qatar Billiards and Snooker Federation (QBSF), held in Doha, Qatar from June 30, 2008 to July 6, 2008;

WHEREAS, Dennis Orcollo distinguished himself by winning the championship, defeating Niels Feijen of the Netherlands, in an impressive 13-5 score;


- 2007 World Straight Pool Championship 5th Place
