AN ACT DECLARING THE SECOND TO THE LAST FRIDAY OF AUGUST OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NONWORKING PUBLIC HOLIDAY FOR THE CITY OF DAVAO TO BE KNOWN AS "INDIGENOUS PEOPLE'S DAY", REPEALING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8969

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. The second to the last Friday of August of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking public holiday for the City of Davao to be known as "Indigenous People's Day".
- SEC. 2. Republic Act No. 8969, entitled "An Act Declaring the Third (3rd) Friday of August of Every Year as a Special Working Public Holiday for the City of Davao", is hereby repealed.
 - SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in at least two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
