AN ACT DECLARING OCTOBER 18 OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL NONWORKING PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TOLOSA, PROVINCE OF LEYTE TO BE KNOWN AS "SEMAPHORE SIGNAL DAY"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. October 18 of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking public holiday in the Municipality of Tolosa, Province of Leyte to be known as "Semaphore Signal Day". This special day shall be observed to commemorate the heroic act of Scout Valeriano Abello who, through semaphore flag signaling, warned American Forces about to bomb the eastern part of Leyte that only Filipino civilians and no Japanese soldiers were in the area.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following the completion of its publication in at least two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
