AN ACT SEPARATING THE BAROTAC VIEJO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL – SANTIAGO ANNEX IN BARANGAY SANTIAGO, MUNICIPALITY OF BAROTAC VIEJO, PROVINCE OF ILOILO FROM THE BAROTAC VIEJO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS SANTIAGO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Separation and Conversion into a National High School. 1 - The Barotac Vieio National High School - Santiago Annex in Barangay 2 Santiago, Municipality of Barotac Viejo, Province of Iloilo is hereby separated 3 from the Barotac Viejo National High School and converted into an 4 5 independent national high school to be known as Santiago National High School. 6 Transfer of Assets and Liabilities. - All personnel, assets, 7 liabilities and records of the Barotac Viejo National High School - Santiago 8 Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Santiago National High 9 10 School.

SEC. 3. Appropriations.

1	Santiago National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged
2	against the current year's appropriations of the Barotac Viejo National High
3	School Santiago Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued
4	operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations
5	Act.

SEC. 4 Implementation. – The Secretary of Education shall issue rules and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

SEC. 5. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette.
