REPRESENTATIVES RODRIGUEZ (R.), RODRIGUEZ (M.), ANGARA, BY. GUNIGUNDO, YAP (S.), AUMENTADO, EVARDONE, HERRERA-DY, MERCADO-REVILLA, GULLAS, TEODORO AND CASTELO, PER COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 911

AN ACT EXPANDING THE PROHIBITED ACTS OF DISCRIMINATION AGAINST WOMEN ON ACCOUNT OF SEX, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE ARTICLES 135 AND 137 OF PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 442, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "LABOR CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES"

## Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled;

1 SECTION 1. Article 135 of Presidential Decree No. 442, as amended, 2 otherwise known as the "Labor Code of the Philippines", is hereby amended to 3 read as follows:

"ARTICLE 135. Discrimination Prohibited. - It shall be 4 unlawful for any employer to discriminate against any woman employee with respect to terms and conditions of employment solely on account of her sex.

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"The following are acts of discrimination:

9 "(a) Payment of a lesser compensation, including wage, 10 salary or other form of remuneration and fringe benefits, to a 11 female employee as against a male employee, for work of equal 12 value; [and]

"(b) Favoring a male employee over a female employee with respect to promotion, ASSIGNMENT, training opportunities, study and scholarship grants solely on account of their sexes[.]; AND

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"(C) FAVORING A MALE EMPLOYEE OVER A FEMALE EMPLOYEE WITH RESPECT TO DISMISSAL OF PERSONNEL OR THE APPLICATION OF ANY RETRENCHMENT POLICY OF THE EMPLOYER SOLELY ON ACCOUNT OF THEIR SEXES.

8 "Criminal liability for the willful commission of any unlawful act as provided in this Article or any violation of the rules and 9 10 regulations issued pursuant to Section 2 hereof shall be penalized 11 as provided in Articles 288 and 289 of this Code: Provided, That the institution of any criminal action under this provision shall not 12 13 bar the aggrieved employee from filing an entirely separate and 14 distinct action for money claims, which may include claims for 15 damages and other affirmative reliefs. The actions hereby 16 authorized shall proceed independently of each other."

SEC. 2. Article 137 of the Labor Code is hereby amended to read asfollows:

19 "ARTICLE 137. Prohibited Acts. - (a) It shall be unlawful
20 for any employer:

"(1) To deny any woman employee the benefits provided for
in this Chapter or to discharge any woman employed by him for the
purpose of preventing her from enjoying any of the benefits
provided under this Code;

"(2) To discharge such woman on account of her pregnancy, or while on leave or in confinement due to her pregnancy; "(3) To discharge or refuse the admission of such woman upon returning to her work for fear that she may again be pregnant[.]; OR

"(4) TO DENY ANY WOMAN THE BENEFITS OF EMPLOYMENT OR OTHER STATUTORY BENEFITS UNDER OUR LAWS BY REASON OF HER SEX.

"ANY EMPLOYER WHO COMMITS OR ATTEMPTS IN ANY 7 8 MANNER TO COMMIT ANY OF THE ACTS PROHIBITED UNDER THIS 9 ARTICLE OR ANY RULE OR REGULATION ISSUED PURSUANT 10 THERETO SHALL, IN ADDITION TO OTHER PENALTIES AS MAY BE 11 PROVIDED BY LAW, UPON CONVICTION, BE PUNISHED BY A FINE 12 OF NOT LESS THAN FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P50,000.00) BUT 13 NOT MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS 14 (P200,000.00), AND SUFFER IMPRISONMENT OF NOT LESS THAN 15 TWO (2) YEARS BUT NOT MORE THAN FOUR (4) YEARS: 16 **PROVIDED, THAT THE CONVICTION OR ACQUITTAL OBTAINED BY** 17 THE EMPLOYER SHALL NOT BE A BAR TO THE FILING BY THE 18 FEMALE EMPLOYEE OF A CIVIL SUIT FOR THE PAYMENT OF 19 SALARIES OR BENEFITS DUE HER.

20"ANY EMPLOYEE OR PERSON WHO WILLFULLY AIDS OR21ABETS IN THE COMMISSION OF THE ACTS PROHIBITED HEREIN22OR WHO CAUSES THE COMMISSION OF ANY SUCH ACTS BY23ANOTHER SHALL BE LIABLE IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE24EMPLOYER."

SEC. 3. Implementing Rules and Regulations. - Within thirty (30)
days from the effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of Labor and Employment,
in consultation with the Tripartite Industrial Peace Council, shall issue and
publish the necessary rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this
Act.

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SEC. 4. Separability Clause. - If any provision of this Act is declared
 unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the
 other provisions hereof.

4 SEC. 5. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, executive orders, presidential 5 decrees, presidential proclamations, rules and regulations or parts thereof 6 inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified 7 accordingly.

8 SEC. 6. Effectivity Clause. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) 9 days after its complete publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of 10 general circulation.
