AN ACT DECLARING THE TENTH DAY OF ZHUL HIJJA, THE TWELFTH MONTH OF THE HIJRAH CALENDAR A NATIONAL HOLIDAY FOR THE OBSERVANCE OF EID'L ADHA, AMENDING FURTHER FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 26, CHAPTER 7 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 292, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1987, AS AMENDED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The tenth day of Zhul Hijja, the twelfth month of the Islamic
2 Calendar, is hereby declared as a national holiday for the observance of Eid'l
3 Adha.

4 SEC. 2. Section 26, Chapter 7 of Executive Order No. 292, otherwise
5 known as the Revised Administrative Code of 1987, as amended, is hereby
6 further amended to read as follows:

7 “SEC. 26. *Regular Holidays and Nationwide Special Days.*

8 – (1) Unless otherwise modified by law, order or proclamation,
9 the following regular holidays and special days shall be observed
10 in the country:

1 a) Regular Holidays

2	New Year's Day	–	January 1
3	Maundy Thursday	–	Movable Date
4	Good Friday	–	Movable Date
5	<i>Eidul Fitr</i>	–	Movable Date
6	EID'L ADHA	–	MOVABLE DATE
7	Araw ng Kagitingan	–	Monday nearest April 9
8	(Bataan and Corregidor Day)		
9	Labor Day	–	Monday nearest May 1
10	Independence Day	–	Monday nearest June 12
11	National Heroes Day	–	Last Sunday of August
12	Bonifacio Day	–	Monday nearest November 30
13	Christmas Day	–	December 25
14	Rizal Day	–	Monday nearest December 30

15 b) Nationwide Special Holidays

16	Ninoy Aquino Day	–	Monday nearest August 21
17	All Saints Day	–	November 1
18	Last Day of the Year	–	December 31"

19 SEC. 3. The implementation of this Act shall be supervised by the
20 Office on Muslim Affairs (OMA) which shall promulgate the rules and
21 regulations pursuant to the provisions of this Act.

22 SEC. 4. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, issuances, rules
23 and regulations and any part thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions
24 of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

25 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete
26 publication in at least two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
