AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SEAWEED PROCESSING PLANT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF INDANAN, PROVINCE OF SULU AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Department of Agriculture, a seaweed processing plant in the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu to be known as the Sulu Seaweed Processing Plant.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of Agriculture shall include in the Department's programs the establishment of the said seaweed processing plant, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. The local government concerned shall set aside funds from any available local revenues in an amount deemed appropriate for its operationalization.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.

Permanent Forest Line. - The permanent forest line or 13 boundary of the forestlands shall be established and clearly marked on the 14 ground by concrete monuments at certain fixed distances, visible cut lines, 15 signboards and uniformly-spaced distinctive trees between the concrete 16 monuments, which shall be maintained at all times. SEC. 6. Non-diminution of the Specific Forest Limits. 17 18 permanent forestlands established pursuant to this Act shall not be diminished or reduced except by an act of Congress. The DENR, in coordination with all 19 agencies and branches of the government, shall see to it that the forest cover 20 21 and vegetation shall be protected, preserved and enhanced. SEC. 7. Subclassification of the Permanent Forestlands. 22 The permanent forestlands shall be subclassified by the DENR into: 23 24 (a) Protection forest; or (b) Production forest after due consultation with the local government 25 26 units (LGUs), concerned communities and other stakeholders. SEC. 8. Status of National Parks, Mineral Lands and Other Public 27 The land classification of proclaimed national parks, 28 Reservations.

- SEC. 9. Appropriations. The sums necessary to initially implement the provisions of this Act shall be taken from available savings of the DENR. Thereafter, the amount needed for the continued operation of the program shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
 - SEC. 10. Implementing Rules and Regulations. Within three (3) months from the effectivity of this Act, the DENR shall issue the implementing rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.
 - SEC. 11. Separability Clause. If any portion of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions not affected thereby.
 - SEC. 12. Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, letters of instruction, executive orders, rules and regulations and other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- SEC. 13. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
