AN ACT SEPARATING THE GAUDENCIO ABORDO MEMORIAL NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL – BALADING ANNEX IN BARANGAY BALADING, MUNICIPALITY OF CUYO, PROVINCE OF PALAWAN FROM THE GAUDENCIO ABORDO MEMORIAL NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS BISUCAY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. *Separation and Conversion into a National High School.*

2           – The Gaudencio Abordo Memorial National High School – Balading Annex  
3           in Barangay Balading, Municipality of Cuyo, Province of Palawan is hereby  
4           separated from the Gaudencio Abordo Memorial National High School and  
5           converted into an independent national high school to be known as Bisucay  
6           National High School.

7           SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,  
8           liabilities and records of the Gaudencio Abordo Memorial National High  
9           School – Balading Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the  
10          Bisucay National High School.

1           SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall  
2 immediately include in the Department’s program the operationalization of the  
3 Bisucay National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged  
4 against the current year’s appropriations of the Gaudencio Abordo Memorial  
5 National High School – Balading Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary  
6 for the continued operation of the school shall be included in the annual  
7 General Appropriations Act.

8           SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue  
9 rules and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this  
10 Act.

11           SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
12 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
