AN ACT SEPARATING THE BULALACAO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL MAUJAO EXTENSION IN BARANGAY MAUJAO, MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO FROM THE BULALAÇÃO NATIONAL CONVERTING SCHOOL. IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS MAUJAO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Separation and Conversion into a National High School.

 The Bulalacao National High School Maujao Extension in Barangay

 Maujao, Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is hereby

 separated from the Bulalacao National High School and converted into an independent national high school to be known as Maujao National High School.
- 7 SEC. 2. Transfer of Assets and Liabilities. All personnel, assets, 8 liabilities and records of the Bulalacao National High School - Maujao

Extension are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Maujao National High

SEC. 4. *Implementation*. – The Secretary of Education shall issue rules and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

SEC. 5. Effectivity. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette.
