AN ACT DECLARING OCTOBER 5 OF EVERY YEAR AS "NATIONAL TEACHERS' DAY"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title. - This Act shall be known as the "National
 Teachers' Day Act of 2011".

3 SEC. 2. Declaration of Policy. – It is hereby declared to be the 4 policy of the State to recognize the essential role of teachers in the educational 5 and moral advancement of the people, especially the youth, and the importance 6 of their contribution to the development of our society.

SEC. 3. Date of Celebration. - The National Teachers' Day shall be
celebrated as a special working holiday on the fifth (5th) day of October of
every year.

10 SEC. 4. Official Celebration. – The Department of Education, the 11 Commission on Higher Education and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority are hereby mandated to initiate the appropriate
 activities to celebrate the National Teachers' Day.

3 SEC. 5. Support and Assistance of Educational Institutions. – All 4 public and private educational institutions in the elementary, secondary and 5 tertiary levels are hereby mandated to provide their full support and assistance 6 to events and activities to be conducted by teachers and students in recognition 7 of the National Teachers' Day.

8 SEC. 6. *Effectivity Clause.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) 9 days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in at least one (1) newspaper 10 of general circulation.
