AN ACT DECLARING SEPTEMBER 3 OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL COMMEMORATIVE DAY TO BE CALLED THE NATIONAL VICTORY AND LIBERATION DAY OF THE PHILIPPINES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. September 3 of every year is hereby declared as National
Victory and Liberation Day of the Philippines and a special nonworking
holiday to commemorate Filipino victory with the surrender of all Japanese
forces in the Philippines at Baguio City on September 3, 1945, thus ending
World War II in the Philippines.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
