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AN ACT DECLARING EVERY SECOND SUNDAY OF OCTOBER AS  
THE NATIONAL ELDERLY FILIPINO BROADCASTING DAY

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. *Short Title.* – This Act shall be known as the “National  
2 Elderly Filipino Broadcasting Day”.

3           SEC. 2. *Declaration of Policy.* – It is the declared policy of the State to  
4 provide adequate social services and an improved quality of life for all.  
5 Pursuant to this policy, the State shall address the promotion of the protection  
6 of senior citizens against all forms of violence and discrimination.

7           SEC. 3. *Guidelines for Implementation.* – In pursuance of this policy,  
8 on every second Sunday of October, television and radio stations nationwide  
9 shall allocate a minimum of thirty (30) minutes of airtime for programs  
10 exclusively for or about elderly Filipinos and produced especially in  
11 observance of the National Elderly Filipino Broadcasting Day.

1           SEC. 4. *Implementing Agencies.* – To ensure the meaningful  
2 observance of this day, heads of government agencies and instrumentalities,  
3 government-owned and -controlled corporations, local government units,  
4 employers in the private sector and the Kapisanan ng mga Broadkaster ng  
5 Pilipinas (KBP) shall encourage and allow sufficient time and opportunities for  
6 their employees to engage and participate in any ceremony or activity within  
7 the premises of their offices or establishments to celebrate the National Elderly  
8 Filipino Broadcasting Day.

9           The Philippine Information Agency (PIA), in coordination with the  
10 KBP, shall initiate and/or monitor programs in the observance of this day.

11           SEC. 5. *Separability Clause.* – If any portion or provision of this Act is  
12 declared void or unconstitutional, the remaining portions or provisions hereof  
13 shall not be affected by such declaration.

14           SEC. 6. *Repealing Clause.* – Any law, presidential decree or issuance,  
15 executive order, letter of instruction, administrative order, rule or regulation  
16 contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act is hereby repealed,  
17 modified or amended accordingly.

18           SEC. 7. *Effectivity Clause.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days  
19 after its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
