AN ACT DECLARING THE NORTHERN NEGROS NATURAL PARK LOCATED IN THE PROVINCE OF NEGROS OCCIDENTAL AS A PROTECTED AREA, PROVIDING FOR ITS MANAGEMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

ARTICLE I

TITLE, POLICY, SCOPE AND DEFINITION OF TERMS

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SECTION 1. *Title.* – This Act shall be known as the “Northern Negros

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Natural Park (NNNP) Act of 2009”.

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SEC. 2. *Statement of Policy.* – Considering the diversity of the NNNP's biological resources and its aesthetic, sociocultural, economic and ecological importance to the Island of Negros, it is hereby declared the policy of the State to ensure its protection and conservation including its communities of people, their culture and way of life insofar as they are in harmony with nature.

The protection and conservation of the NNNP shall be pursued through sustainable and participatory development, advancing and protecting the

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1 interests of its legitimate inhabitants, and honoring customary laws in
2 accordance with Republic Act No. 7586 or the National Integrated Protected
3 Areas System (NIPAS) Act of 1992, Republic Act No. 8371 or the Indigenous
4 People's Rights Act (IPRA) of 1997 and international conventions to which the
5 Philippines is a signatory such as, but not limited to, the Convention on
6 International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES),
7 the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), the International Union for
8 Conservation of Nature (IUCN) and others.

9 SEC. 3. *Declaration and Scope.* – The NNNP, which is located in the
10 Province of Negros Occidental, specifically in the cities of Talisay, Silay,
11 Victorias, Cadiz, Sagay and San Carlos and in the municipalities of Murcia,
12 E.B. Magalona, Toboso, Calatrava and Don Salvador Benedicto, is hereby
13 declared and established as a protected area under the category of natural park
14 pursuant to the NIPAS Act of 1992.

15 The boundaries of the NNNP are hereby described as follows:

Any modification of the coverage of this Act due to such factors as changing ecological situations, new scientific or archaeological findings not previously taken into account shall be made through an act of Congress, after consultation with the affected public and concerned government agencies.

1 SEC. 4. *Land Classification.* – All lands of the public domain
2 comprising the NNNP shall fall under the classification of national park as
3 provided for in the Philippine Constitution.

4 SEC. 5. *Definition of Terms.* – The following terms are hereby defined
5 for purposes of this Act:

6 (a) “Biodiversity or biological diversity” shall refer to the variability
7 among living organisms from all sources including, *inter alia*, terrestrial,
8 marine and other aquatic ecosystems, and the ecological complexes of which
9 they are part. This definition includes diversity within species, between
10 species and of ecosystems.

11 (b) “Bioprospecting” shall refer to the research, collection and
12 utilization of biological and genetic resources for purposes of applying the
13 knowledge derived from these resources for commercial purposes.

14 (c) “Green belt areas” shall refer to the areas immediately after the
15 strict protection zone to be planted with evergreen species of plants for the
16 purpose of securing the forest from fire and other forms of destruction.

17 (d) “Commercial” shall refer to marketing of goods whose volume or
18 value is in excess of that required to maintain basic subsistence for workers
19 and their dependents.

20 (e) “Ecotourism/Ecological tourism” shall refer to a form of
21 sustainable tourism within a natural and cultural heritage area where
22 community participation, protection and management of natural resources,
23 culture and indigenous knowledge and practices, environmental education and
24 ethics as well as economic benefits are fostered and pursued for the enrichment
25 of host communities and satisfaction of visitors.

26 (f) “Ecotourism sites” shall refer to those areas lawfully declared as
27 such through local ordinance, presidential proclamation or through an act of
28 Congress.

1 (g) "Integrated Social Forestry Projects" shall refer to those areas
2 covered by the Integrated Social Forestry Program (ISFP) of the Department of
3 Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), launched under Letter of
4 Instruction No. 1260, wherein a beneficiary is issued a Certificate of
5 Stewardship Contract (CSC) to occupy and possess a parcel of public land up
6 to seven (7) hectares for a period of twenty-five (25) years, renewable for the
7 same period. The management of the ISFP projects have been devolved by the
8 DENR to the local government units (LGUs).

9 (h) "Environment and Natural Resources Office (ENRO)" shall refer to
10 the local environment office created and/or to be created at the municipal or
11 city level which shall handle natural resources and environment-related issues
12 and concerns, including programs and projects of the national government
13 devolved under the Local Government Code of 1991.

14 (i) "Exotic species" shall refer to species or subspecies that do not
15 naturally occur within the biogeographic region of the NNNP at the present or
16 in historical time.

17 (j) "Forest products" shall refer to timber, pulpwood, firewood, bark,
18 tree top, resin, gum, wood, oil, honey beeswax, nipa, rattan or other forest
19 growth such as grass, shrub and flowering plant, including the associated
20 water, fish, game, scenic, historical, recreational and geologic resources in
21 forestlands.

22 (k) "Indigenous cultural communities/Indigenous peoples (ICCs/IPs)"
23 shall refer to the indigenous peoples, as defined in the IPRA, of the NNNP.

24 (l) "Motorized equipment" shall refer to any equipment powered by a
25 gasoline or a diesel engine such as chainsaw, band saw, motorcycle, motor
26 vehicle, etc.

1 (m) “Multi-use zone” shall refer to areas where settlement, traditional
2 and/or sustainable land use, including agriculture, agro-forestry, extraction
3 activities and other income generating or livelihood activities may be allowed
4 to the extent prescribed in the management plan. Land tenure within the multi-
5 use zone may be granted to tenured residents, whether indigenous cultural
6 community members or migrants.

7 (n) “Natural park” shall refer to a relatively large area of the public
8 domain not materially altered by human activity, where extractive resource
9 uses are not allowed, and are maintained to protect outstanding natural and
10 scenic areas of national or international significance, for scientific, educational
11 or recreational use.

12 (o) Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF)” shall refer to the funds or
13 revenues derived from the proceeds of the lease of multiple-use areas,
14 including tourism concessions, contributions from industries and facilities,
15 fines and fees including entry fees collected and derived from the operation of
16 the park, contributions, donations, endowments and grants from any source and
17 such other revenues as may be derived from the operation of the protected
18 areas.

19 (p) “Nongovernmental organization (NGO)” shall refer to any civic,
20 developmental, environmental or philanthropic nonstock, nonprofit
21 organization, duly registered, having bylaws, with democratically-elected
22 representation and multi-sectoral in character.

23 (q) “Nonrenewable resources” shall refer to those resources found
24 within the NNNP, the natural replenishment rate of which is not known.

25 (r) “Nontimber products” shall refer to all goods derived from forests
26 of both plant and animal origin other than timber and firewood.

1 (s) Northern Negros Forest Reserve (NNFR)" refers to the forestland
2 declared as such by virtue of Proclamation No. 798 (FR 48) dated 29 April
3 1935, as amended by Proclamation No. 07 (FR 48-1) dated 07 August 1946.

4 (t) "Provincial Environment Management Office (PEMO)" shall refer
5 to the local environment office under the Office of the Governor of Negros
6 Occidental.

7 (u) "People's organization (PO)" shall refer to any group of people
8 organized to advance the interests of their sector.

9 (v) "Protected areas" shall refer to identified portions of land and water
10 set aside by reason of their unique physical and biological significance,
11 managed to enhance biological diversity and protected against destructive
12 human exploitation.

13 (w) Threatened species" shall refer to a species or sub-species
14 considered as critically-endangered, endangered, vulnerable or other accepted
15 categories of wildlife whose population is at risk of extinction.

16 (x) Strict nature reserve" shall refer to an area possessing outstanding
17 ecosystem, features and/or species of flora and fauna of national scientific
18 importance, maintained to protect nature and processes in an undisturbed state
19 in order to have ecologically representative samples of the natural environment
20 available for scientific study, environmental monitoring, education and for the
21 maintenance of genetic resources in a dynamic and evolutionary state.

22 (y) "Strict protection zone" shall refer to an area with high biodiversity
23 value which shall be closed to all human activity except for scientific studies
24 and/or ceremonial or religious use by indigenous communities.

25 (z) "Tenured migrant" shall refer to any person who has actually and
26 continuously occupied an area in the NNNP for at least five (5) years prior to
27 its designation as part of a protected area and is solely dependent on that area
28 for subsistence.

1 (aa) "Timber product" shall refer to any piece of wood more than one
 2 and a half (1.5) meters long and having an average diameter of more than
 3 fifteen (15) centimeters.

4 SEC. 6. *Exclusion of Municipality of Don Salvador Benedicto Town*
 5 *Site.* — An area within the NNFR is hereby reserved for the town site of the
 6 Municipality of Don Salvador Benedicto and is excluded from the coverage of
 7 this Act, with the following technical description:

12 The Don Salvador Benedicto town site shall fall under the classification
 13 of agricultural land as provided for in the Philippine Constitution, subject to
 14 disposition pursuant to the pertinent provisions of Commonwealth Act No. 141
 15 or the Public Land Act, as amended, and other public land laws.

16 SEC. 7. *Special Use Areas.* – Certain areas inside the NNNP may be set
 17 aside for special uses and purposes such as sites for communication
 18 transmitter, irrigation canal, energy power generation with a maximum of two
 19 (2) megawatts, laboratory or research and other similar uses: *Provided*, That
 20 the activities to be undertaken in these special use areas shall have no drastic
 21 effect to the biodiversity of the NNNP and its immediate environment:
 22 *Provided, further*, That the project shall primarily be beneficial to the people
 23 of Negros Occidental: *Provided, finally*, That a development plan specific to
 24 each project and consistent with the approved management plan is presented
 25 and approved first by the Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) before
 26 the start of project implementation and/or further operation.

1 ARTICLE II

2 MANAGEMENT OF THE NNNP

3 SEC. 8. *Management.* – The management and administration of the
4 NNNP shall be vested with the PAMB: *Provided, however,* That the
5 management of zones within the NNNP shall be consultative and participatory.

6 SEC. 9. *Local Government Units (LGUs).* – The LGUs shall participate
7 in the management of the NNNP through their representatives in the PAMB.
8 To allow the integration of the objectives of the NNNP with the development
9 plans for the Province of Negros Occidental, the LGUs shall ensure that local
10 ordinances relating to the environment including the allocation of funds for
11 environmental programs are consistent with this Act and the management plan
12 as herein provided.

13 It shall be mandatory for every LGU within the NNNP to create or
14 establish an ENRO, in the nature of a department, for the purpose of
15 implementing all environment-related programs in their respective areas of
16 jurisdiction. The creation of an ENRO shall be exempted from the ceiling for
17 personal services set by the Department of Budget and Management.

18 SEC. 10. *General Management Plan.* – In order to achieve the
19 objectives of this Act, there shall be a thirty (30)-year general management
20 plan which shall provide a long-term basic framework on the management of
21 the NNNP, govern all activities within the NNNP and serve as guide in the
22 preparation of its annual operations and budget. The management plan shall
23 identify the allowed uses for each zone.

24 For specialized uses such as academic and scientific purposes,
25 commercial and industrial uses, consultations shall be conducted by a
26 committee of four (4) PAMB representatives and four (4) representatives from

1 each concerned LGU: *Provided*, That PAMB representatives shall not come
2 from any of the involved LGUs. The management plan shall be consistent with
3 the nature of the NNNP as a protected area under the category of a natural
4 park.

5 Within one (1) year from the effectivity of this Act, the Protected Area
6 Superintendent (PASu) shall prepare the management plan in accordance with
7 the General Management Planning Strategy as provided for in the NIPAS Act,
8 in coordination and consultation with the appropriate offices of the DENR,
9 LGUs, local communities and experts who may offer their services. It shall
10 contain, among others, the following:

- 11 (a) A period of applicability for thirty (30) years subject to periodic
12 review every five (5) years;
- 13 (b) Key management issues;
- 14 (c) Goals and objectives of management in support of Section 2
15 hereof;
- 16 (d) Site management strategies;
- 17 (e) Zoning in accordance with Section 11 hereof;
- 18 (f) Management programs to include enforcement of laws, habitat and
19 wildlife management, ecotourism, sustainable-use management, infrastructure
20 development and maintenance, fire prevention and pest control;
- 21 (g) Mechanisms for protection of ICCs/IPs and tenured migrants in
22 the exercise of their rights;
- 23 (h) Sustainable and non-destructive livelihood activities; and
- 24 (i) Regulations in furtherance of the preservation and conservation
25 objectives of the NNNP as a protected area such as the issuance of permits,
26 resource-use restrictions, among others.

1 The management plan shall be reviewed and adopted by the PAMB and
2 certified to by the DENR Secretary that it conforms to all laws, rules and
3 regulations issued by the DENR. The management plan shall not be revised
4 nor modified without prior consultation with the PAMB and must be in
5 accordance with the procedure herein set forth.

6 The management plan shall be periodically reviewed and shall be
7 updated every five (5) years. Pertinent proposed changes thereto shall be made
8 available for public consultation and shall be published in a local newspaper of
9 general circulation during the first quarter of the fifth (5th) year.

10 A year before the expiration of the General Management Plan, the PASu
11 shall cause the publication of notices for comments and suggestions on the
12 successor plan in a newspaper of local circulation and the posting of such
13 notices in the provincial, municipal and barangay halls of the LGUs
14 comprising the NNNP, and in three (3) other conspicuous areas frequented by
15 the public within the NNNP. Two (2) public hearings on the same calendar
16 year shall be conducted on the successor plan. The proposed management plan
17 shall be made available for public perusal at the office of the PASu.

18 The management plan shall be prepared in English, plainly written and
19 available for public perusal at the office of the PASu.

20 An annual work and financial plan shall be prepared and presented by
21 the PASu to the PAMB for approval.

22 SEC. 11. *Zoning.* — Management zones shall be established within the
23 NNNP, giving primary consideration to its protection and conservation.
24 Zoning shall also take into account the tenurial and livelihood concerns of
25 communities to ensure the efficient protection of habitats, fragile ecosystems
26 and unique areas.

The establishment and management of zones shall involve the community concerned by undertaking such steps as dialogues and consultations and land and resource-use mapping with the aid of geographic information system (GIS) and the latest data gathering technologies. Zones shall be demarcated on the ground and indicated on maps with the participation of communities, LGUs and other stakeholders.

ARTICLE III

INSTITUTIONAL MECHANISMS

9 SEC. 12. *Institutional Mechanisms.* -- (a) The PAMB shall be the
10 policy-making body of the NNNP. It shall be composed of:

(1) The Regional Executive Director (RED) of DENR-Region VI as Chairperson;

13 (2) The Governor of Negros Occidental as Co-chairperson;

(3) The Sangguniang Panlalawigan (SP) chairman of the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Protection;

16 (4) The mayors of the municipalities and cities with territory within the
17 NNNP or their respective duly authorized regular representatives;

18 (5) All barangay captains of barangays with territory within the NNNP
19 or their respective duly authorized regular representatives;

20 (6) Three (3) representatives from NGOs based in Negros Occidental,
21 operating within the NNNP, which are accredited with the DENR and the
22 provincial government and with tangible projects at the time of their
23 membership in the PAMB;

(7) A PO representative chosen from among the POs concerned for each municipality and city with territory within the NNNP: *Provided*, That the POs are accredited with the LGU and with tangible projects at the time of their membership in the PAMB;

(8) The head of the PEMO of Negros Occidental;

(9) An ICC/IP representative for each tribal community within the NNNP; and

(10) A representative from other national government agencies with existing projects in the protected area, to be appointed by the DENR Secretary upon the recommendation of the PAMB.

(b) Every PAMB member shall serve for a term of five (5) years: *Provided*, That he/she remains connected with the sector being represented: *Provided, further*, That the term of office of an NGO/PO representative in the PAMB shall be coterminous with the duration or existence of the organization's projects within the NNNP. Whenever a vacancy occurs during the term of a nongovernment PAMB member, a new member shall be chosen in the same manner as the original selection process: *Provided*, That he/she shall only serve for the remaining term.

(c) The PAMB *en banc* shall hold regular meetings at least once a year. Special meetings may be called upon proper notice as the need arises.

SEC. 13. Functions of the PAMB. — The PAMB shall decide by a majority vote and shall have the following powers and functions:

(a) Issue all rules and regulations to prohibit and regulate acts that may be prejudicial to the NNNP pursuant to the policy declarations herein set forth;

(b) Issue all necessary permits within the NNNP in accordance with the management plan and pertinent environmental laws, rules and regulations;

(c) Recommend to the DENR Secretary the criteria on fees for the issuance of permits for activities regulated by this Act or the management plan;

(d) Evaluate and approve project or program proposals to be implemented within the NNNP;

(e) Adopt rules of procedures for the conduct of business, including the creation of committees to whom its powers may be delegated;

(f) Approve the management plan and oversee the office of the PASu;

1 (g) Deputize, through the PASu, interested individuals for the
2 enforcement of the laws, rules and regulations governing conduct within the
3 NNNP and prescribe the necessary qualifications therefore;

4 (h) Accept donations, approve proposals for funding, budget
5 allocations and exercise accountability over all funds that may accrue to the
6 NNNP;

7 (i) Coordinate with the appropriate agencies of the government, such
8 as the regulation of flight patterns of aircraft going over the area in terms of
9 altitudinal limits and emissions;

10 (j) Retain legal counsel, either on a permanent or temporary basis, to
11 defend cases against the PAMB, the PASu staff and deputized individuals
12 whenever they are engaged in connection with the performance of their duties
13 under this Act, and to assist in other PAMB legal matters; and

14 (k) Delegate limited authority to the PASu.

15 The DENR, through the RED of Region VI, shall ensure that the PAMB
16 acts within the scope of its powers and functions. In case of conflict between
17 administrative orders issued by the DENR pursuant to the NIPAS Act and the
18 rules and regulations or resolutions issued by the PAMB, the DENR Secretary
19 shall decide whether to apply the rule or withdraw its application in the NNNP.

20 SEC. 14. *Northern Negros Natural Park Protected Area*
21 *Superintendent's Office.* – There is hereby established a protected area
22 superintendent's office in charge of the management, protection and
23 administration of the protected area. The PASu shall be supported by the
24 existing personnel of the DENR. The head of office shall be the chief
25 operating officer of the NNNP and shall be accountable to the RED of the
26 DENR-Region VI and the PAMB. The PASu shall have the following powers
27 and functions:

28 (a) Prepare the management plan as herein provided;

1 (b) Serve as head of the secretariat for the PAMB with the duty to
2 provide the PAMB with all the information necessary for it to make
3 appropriate decisions;

4 (c) Supervise the necessary personnel to support operations which shall
5 be included in the annual budget of the DENR/Province;

6 (d) Establish a productive partnership with the local community,
7 including groups interested in the achievement of the goals and objectives of
8 the NNNP and in the planning, protection and management thereof;

9 (e) Facilitate the development and implementation of park information,
10 education and visitor programs;

11 (f) Enforce laws, rules and regulations relevant to the NNNP and assist
12 in the prosecution of offenses;

13 (g) Facilitate the development and implementation of monitoring
14 information system that encompasses all activities within the NNNP in
15 conformity with the management plan;

16 (h) Report the results of monitoring and evaluation activities every
17 PAMB meeting;

18 (i) Mobilize resources for the implementation of the management plan;
19 and

20 (j) Perform such other functions as the PAMB may assign.

21 SEC. 15. *Deputy Protected Area Superintendent.* – There shall be an
22 office of the local protected area superintendent within each LGU to be headed
23 by a Deputy Protected Area Superintendent (DPASu), who shall
24 be the Environment and Natural Resources Officer of the concerned
25 municipality/city, unless the local chief executive may opt to appoint another
26 person as DPASu subject to confirmation by the PAMB. The DPASu shall be
27 directly accountable to the PASu and the PAMB. The DPASu within their area
28 of jurisdiction shall have the following powers and functions:

- 1 (a) Establish a productive partnership with the local community,
2 including groups interested in the achievement of the goals and objectives of
3 the NNNP and in the planning, protection and management thereof;
- 4 (b) Develop and implement park information, education and visitor
5 programs;
- 6 (c) Enforce laws, rules and regulations relevant to the NNNP and assist
7 in the prosecution of offenses;
- 8 (d) Develop and implement a monitoring information system that
9 encompasses all activities for conformity with the management plan;
- 10 (e) Prepare monitoring and evaluation report to be presented every
11 PAMB meeting;
- 12 (f) Mobilize resources for the implementation of the projects and
13 programs in accordance with the management plan; and
- 14 (g) Perform such other functions related to the NNNP as the PASu and
15 the PAMB may assign.

ARTICLE IV

ANCESTRAL LANDS/DOMAINS, TENURED MIGRANTS AND OTHER OCCUPANTS

19 SEC. 16. *Ancestral Lands and Domains.* – The rights of ICCs/IPs in the
20 NNNP to their ancestral lands and domains shall be recognized subject to
21 existing and prior property rights. Traditional property regimes exercised by
22 the ICCs/IPs in accordance with their customary laws shall govern the
23 relationship of all individuals within their communities with respect to all lands
24 and other resources found within their ancestral lands and domains.

25 The provisions of this Act shall be construed liberally in favor of the
26 ICCs/IPs in accordance with the preservation and conservation objectives of
27 the NNNP. Nothing herein shall be construed to impair, diminish or derogate
28 any prior or existing right currently enjoyed by the ICCs/IPs under existing
29 laws.

1 SEC. 17. *Tenured Migrants.* – Tenured migrants are members of
2 households that have actually and continuously occupied an area within the
3 NNNP prior to August 15, 2000 and are solely dependent on the NNNP for
4 their livelihood. For purposes of official documentation of rights and extent of
5 occupation within the NNNP, a tenured migrant household shall be issued a
6 tenurial instrument over such areas as have been occupied or cultivated by
7 them but not to exceed a maximum of three (3) hectares.

8 Holders of certificates of stewardship contract (CSC) and other holders
9 of usufruct documents in good standing, as determined by the PAMB, shall
10 continue to enjoy their privileges which shall be governed by existing DENR
11 rules and regulations.

12 In the event that areas occupied by tenured migrants and other
13 occupants holding valid leases, agreements and contracts such as the
14 Socialized Integrated Forest Management Agreement (SIFMA) and similar
15 instruments are designated as zones in which no occupation or other activities
16 are allowed, provisions for the transfer of these tenured occupants to
17 multiple-use zones and/or payment of due compensation shall be accomplished
18 using humanitarian considerations.

19 To provide a social fence to prevent encroachment into the NNNP,
20 the tenurial instruments to be issued pursuant to this Act must be
21 community-based, limited solely to multiple-use zones, promote clustering and
22 comply with the zoning and management plans, as provided herein.

23 The right to the tenurial instruments can only be transferred to the direct
24 descendants.

25 Tenurial instruments or the rights and interests therein shall not be
26 transferred, sold, leased, encumbered or made as a collateral, security or joint
27 venture capital, otherwise the transaction is void and the tenurial instrument
28 shall be cancelled.

Any violation of the terms and conditions of the tenurial instruments or
any provision of this Act or abandonment by a tenured migrant shall constitute
sufficient ground for the revocation of the instrument.

Upon cancellation of a tenured migrant instrument for cause or by voluntary surrender of rights, the PASu shall take immediate steps to rehabilitate the area in order to return it to its natural state prior to the cultivation or other acts by the tenured migrant.

8 Occupants who do not qualify as tenured migrants but have been
9 occupying areas of the NNFR prior to the enactment of this Act shall be
10 relocated to the multiple-use areas or available agricultural lands of the public
11 domain that are near their original abode. Occupants who shall be relocated
12 within the multiple-use zones shall qualify for usufruct use while those
13 relocated to the agricultural lands may apply for ownership titles. Park
14 occupants shall be given priority in the government's relocation programs.

ARTICLE V

PROHIBITED ACTS

17 SEC. 18. *Prohibited Acts.* – The following shall be the prohibitions and
18 penalties applicable within the NNNP:

19 (a) A fine of not less than Five thousand pesos (P5,000.00) but not
20 more than Five hundred thousand pesos (P500,000.00) and/or imprisonment of
21 not less than six (6) years and one (1) day but not more than twelve (12) years
22 shall be imposed upon any person who:

(1) Hunts, collects, destroys, traps, disturbs or possesses anywhere within the NNNP any wild plant or animal or product including minerals derived therefrom without prior PAMB permit;

26 (2) Possesses without a permit from the PAMB any wild plant or
27 animal or product derived therefrom outside the NNNP or any zone of the
28 NNNP where the species is endemic;

1 (3) Cuts, gathers, collects or removes timber or other forest products as
2 well as undertakes any activity not compatible with the use of the respective
3 zones within the NNNP without prior PAMB permit: *Provided*, That any
4 permit issued shall be valid for only one (1) month from the date of issue either
5 to tenured migrants within sustainable monitored and controlled quotas or for
6 scientific purposes necessary for protected area management in accordance
7 with existing guidelines and outside the strict protection zones;

8 (4) Establishes or introduces exotic species within the NNNP with
9 allelopathic effect or those detrimental to endemic species, or without prior
10 PAMB permit; and

11 (5) Engages in kaingin or in any form of slash-and-burn activity or
12 deliberately causes forest fire inside the NNNP.

13 (b) A fine of not less than Five thousand pesos (P5,000.00) but not
14 more than Two hundred fifty thousand pesos (P250,000.00) and/or
15 imprisonment of not less than six (6) months but not more than six (6) years
16 and the restoration and rehabilitation of the damage shall be imposed upon any
17 person who:

18 (1) Violates the management plan or any resolution issued by the
19 PAMB;

20 (2) Vandalizes, mutilates, transports, destroys, excavates or in any
21 manner intentionally damages any natural formation or object of natural beauty
22 inside the NNNP or the burial or religious sites including artifacts and other
23 objects belonging to the ICCs/IPs;

24 (3) Dumps, burns or otherwise disposes of any substance deleterious to
25 the ecosystem, plants and animals or human inhabitants in the protected area or
26 committing the same in buffer and multiple-use areas without appropriate
27 authority or permit;

1 (4) Uses or possesses a motorized equipment anywhere within the strict
2 protection zone of the NNNP without a prior permit from the PAMB;

3 (5) Uses or possesses chainsaws and band saws without prior PAMB
4 permit: *Provided*, That permits may only be issued for use in multiple-use
5 zones;

6 (6) Grazing or raising of poultry and other livestock for commercial
7 purpose within the NNNP by private individuals or entities who have no valid
8 permits and not a holder of valid tenurial instrument: *Provided*, That existing
9 grazing or poultry and other livestock farms within the NNNP shall be phased
10 out within five (5) years;

11 (7) Damaging or leaving roads and trails in damaged condition;

12 (8) Occupies any portion of land inside the NNNP without a prior
13 PAMB permit, the clearing, construction of residence or any introduction of
14 improvements therein constituting *prima facie* evidence of occupation or
15 settlement;

16 (9) Altering, removing, destroying or defacing boundaries, marks or
17 signs;

18 (10) Constructs and maintains a building, edifice or any kind of
19 structure or conducts any business enterprise within the NNNP without prior
20 PAMB permit;

21 (11) Enters the NNNP without prior PAMB permit for purposes of
22 trekking, mountain climbing, camping, spelunking and the like;

23 (12) Conducts bioprospecting within the NNNP without prior PAMB
24 permit in violation of existing guidelines; and

25 (13) Engages in treasure hunting within the NNNP.

26 (c) A fine of not less than One hundred thousand pesos (P100,000.00)
27 but not more than Five hundred thousand pesos (P500,000.00) and/or
28 imprisonment of not less than six (6) months but not more than six (6) years

1 shall be imposed upon any public officer or officer of the law, who, in
2 dereliction of the duties of his office, shall maliciously refrain from instituting
3 prosecution for the punishment of violators of the law, or shall tolerate the
4 commission of offenses. Conviction of this offense shall also carry the penalty
5 of perpetual disqualification from public office.

6 (d) Any provision to the contrary notwithstanding, the commission of
7 any unlawful act enumerated under Section 18(a) herein shall carry the penalty
8 of imprisonment of not less than twelve (12) years and one (1) day but not
9 more than twenty (20) years and a fine of not less than Five hundred thousand
10 pesos (P500,000.00) to One million pesos (P1,000,000.00) in addition to the
11 accessory penalties provided in the immediately succeeding paragraph, in case
12 the species involved is a protected species as defined herein. Furthermore, any
13 citizen may institute the necessary charge against the offender for commission
14 of the acts enumerated under Section 18(a) involving protected species.

15 (e) A conviction under this section shall likewise carry the penalty of
16 eviction from the NNNP, payment of damages for rehabilitation and
17 restoration, and the forfeiture of all equipment, device weapon/s used in the
18 commission of the offense as well as the protected area resources caught in the
19 possession of the accused. In case the offender is not a citizen of the
20 Philippines, he/she shall be immediately deported to his/her country of origin
21 after service of his/her sentence if the offender is an association or corporation,
22 the president or manager shall be directly responsible for the act of his/her
23 employees and laborers.

24 (f) The PASu or his/her duly deputized personnel may arrest even
25 without a warrant any person who has committed or is committing in his/her
26 presence any of the offenses defined in this section. He/She may also seize and
27 confiscate in favor of the government, the tools and equipment used in

1 committing the offense and the resources caught in the possession of the
2 offender and file the necessary charges therefor: *Provided*, That the DENR
3 may impose administrative fines and penalties in accordance with law.

4 (g) In case of conviction, the penalty consisting of fines and damages
5 shall directly accrue to the Integrated Protected Area Fund as provided in
6 Section 20 herein.

7 SEC. 19. *Special Prosecutors*. – Within thirty (30) days from the
8 effectivity of this Act, the Department of Justice shall designate a special
9 prosecutor to whom all cases of violation of laws, rules and regulations in the
10 NNNP shall be assigned. Such special prosecutor shall coordinate with the
11 PAMB and the PASu in the performance of his/her duties and assist in the
12 training of wardens and rangers in arrest and criminal procedure.

ARTICLE VI

PROCEEDS AND FEES

15 SEC. 20. *Integrated Protected Areas Fund*. – There is hereby
16 established a trust fund to be known as the NNNP Integrated Protected Areas
17 Fund (IPAF) for purposes of financing projects of the system. All incomes
18 generated from the operation of the system or management of wild flora and
19 fauna in the NNNP shall accrue to the fund. These income shall be derived
20 from proceeds from fees from the protected area other than protected species
21 as may be set by the DENR and the PAMB, proceeds from lease of
22 multiple-use areas, environmental services such as watersheds, biodiversity,
23 carbon sequestration and carbon sinks, contributions from industries and
24 facilities directly benefiting from the protected area, and such other fees and
25 incomes derived from the operation of the protected area.

26 The fund may be augmented by grants, donations, endowment from
27 various sources, domestic or foreign, for purposes related to their functions:
28 *Provided*, That the fund shall be deposited as a special account in the national

1 treasury and disbursements therefrom shall be made solely for the protection,
2 maintenance, administration and management of the system, and duly approved
3 projects endorsed by the PAMB in accordance with existing accounting and
4 budgeting rules and regulations: *Provided, further,* That the fund shall not be
5 used to cover personal services expenditures.

6 The LGUs shall continue to impose and collect all other fees not
7 enumerated herein which they have traditionally collected, such as business
8 permits, property tax and rentals of LGU facilities. Furthermore, the LGUs
9 may charge add-ons to fees imposed by the PAMB: *Provided,* That such
10 add-ons shall be determined based on the contribution of the LGUs in the
11 maintenance and protection of the protected area.

12 The PAMB shall have the power to disburse the IPA. Twenty-five
13 percent (25%) of the IPA shall be for the use of the national government for
14 the support of the NIPAS: *Provided,* That at least seventy-five percent (75%)
15 thereof shall be allocated to the LGUs comprising the NNNP: *Provided,*
16 *further,* That donations, grants and contributions from the local and foreign
17 sources shall be excluded from the IPA, and thereby one hundred percent
18 (100%) thereof shall be allocated to the NNNP fund.

19 ARTICLE VII

20 EXISTING FACILITIES

21 SEC. 21. *Existing Facilities within the NNNP.* – Within ninety (90)
22 days from the effectivity of this Act, all commercial facilities existing within
23 the NNNP with a total capitalization of not less than One hundred thousand
24 pesos (P100,000.00) shall submit to the PAMB, through the PASu, a sworn
25 statement containing the following information:

- 26 (a) Potential for disturbance of protected species and other habitats,
27 reproductive cycles, nesting and feeding grounds and migratory paths;
- 28 (b) Noise levels at all stages of operation;

- 1 (c) Emissions and effluent at all stages of operation;
- 2 (d) Type and volume of solid wastes generated and management
- 3 schemes for these;
- 4 (e) Energy requirements and sources of energy;
- 5 (f) Water supply requirements and sources of water;
- 6 (g) Volume of resources extracted from the NNNP; and
- 7 (h) Future plans for the next five (5) years.

8 Based on these submissions, the PAMB, with the assistance of the
9 DENR, shall determine whether the existence of such facility and its future
10 plans and operations will be detrimental to the NNNP.

11 Failure to submit the required information shall constitute a violation of
12 this Act and subject to the penalties imposed under Section 18(b) hereof.
13 The PAMB may prescribe further conditions for the operation of the facility to
14 ensure that it does not contradict the management objectives of the NNNP.
15 Without prejudice to the filing of the necessary case under Section 18(b)
16 hereof, if any of such conditions is violated, an administrative fine of Five
17 thousand pesos (P5,000.00) for every day of violation shall be imposed upon
18 the owners of said facility but not to exceed a total of Five hundred thousand
19 pesos (P500,000.00). At anytime whenever necessary, the PAMB, through the
20 PASu or other government entities, shall cause the closure and demolition of
21 the facility at the cost of its owners. Existing facilities that rely heavily on
22 resources within the NNNP which are allowed to remain within the NNNP may
23 be charged reasonable fees or subject to reasonable conditions by the PAMB.
24 All incomes derived from such fees shall accrue to the IPAFA.

25 Further, newly constructed noncommercial facilities such as rest houses,
26 swimming pool and the like, inside the NNNP, regardless of monetary value,
27 owned by private individuals who are not actual occupants nor qualified
28 tenured migrants and/or holders of valid usufruct instrument shall, within

1 ninety (90) days, be demolished at the cost of its owner. Otherwise, the same
2 shall be subjected to the penalties as provided in Section 18(b) herein:
3 *Provided, however,* That in case the structure has been in existence for five (5)
4 years prior to the designation of the NNNP as a protected area and does not
5 contribute negative impact to the immediate environment, as determined by the
6 PAMB through the PASu, the same shall be legalized upon submission to the
7 office of the PASu of the appropriate documents required for its legitimacy.

ARTICLE VIII

UTILIZATION OF RESOURCES

10 SEC. 22. *Utilization of Resources.* – Except for protected species or
11 whenever detrimental to the ecosystem, use of resources derived from the
12 NNNP by tenured migrants and ICCs/IPs for their domestic needs or for their
13 subsistence shall not be restricted.

14 Livelihood activities requiring the use of resources derived from the
15 NNNP shall be allowed only when sustainable or consistent with the
16 management plan and only upon prior PAMB approval.

17 Exploration, exploitation or utilization of nonrenewable resources
18 within the NNNP shall not be allowed for commercial purposes, except in
19 cases of commercial utilization by tenured migrants and the ICCs/IPs as may
20 hereinafter be allowed upon prior PAMB approval, in conformity with the
21 management plan.

Commercial exploitation of water resources, renewable energy (wind, solar, hydro, biomass) within the NNNP shall require prior PAMB approval, must be in accordance with the management plan, should undergo the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) System and established outside the strict protection zone.

ARTICLE IX

TRANSITORY AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

SEC. 23. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of the DENR shall immediately include in the Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 24. *Transitory Provisions.* – Pending the organization of a new PAMB in accordance with this Act, the members of the interim PAMB shall continue to hold office until the PAMB has been convened within three (3) months from the effectivity of this Act. The current members of the technical working group (TWG) of the NNNP and the PEMO, acting as secretariat, shall continue to discharge their functions until the office of the PASu is officially created and staffed.

Within three (3) months from the effectivity of this Act, the DENR and the TWG, in coordination with the PAMB, the Committee on Natural Resources of the House of Representatives, the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources and the concerned district representatives or their representatives shall undertake the preparation of the implementing rules and regulations of this Act.

The PAMB, in coordination with the DENR and the Office of the Solicitor General, shall work for the cancellation and/or reversion of illegally issued land titles inside the NNNP.

SEC. 25. *Construction.* – The provisions of this Act shall be construed liberally in favor of tenured migrants, ICCs/IPs and other qualified occupants and with due consideration to the protection of biodiversity. The NIPAS Act shall be suppletory in the implementation of this Act.

1 SEC. 26. *Separability Clause.* – If any part or section of this Act is
2 declared unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the other parts or
3 sections hereof.

4 SEC. 27. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, proclamations, rules and
5 regulations inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified
6 accordingly.

7 SEC. 28. *Effectivity Clause.* – This Act shall be effective fifteen (15)
8 days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
