AN ACT DECLARING A PARCEL OF LAND OF THE PUBLIC DOMAIN LOCATED IN MAKESI ISLAND, BARANGAY MANALO, PUERTO PRINCESA CITY, PALAWAN PROVINCE AN AGRICULTURAL LAND

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Declaration of Agricultural Land A parcel of land of			
the public domain located in Makesi Island, Barangay Manalo, Puerto Princesa			
City, Palawan Province is hereby declared an agricultural land. The said parcel			
of land is more particularly described as follows:			
Paginning at corner marked "1" which is NI 25012' E 16 200 75			

Beginning at corner marked "1" which is N. 25°13' E., 16,298.75 meters from BLLM 1, Cad 800D, Puerto Prinsesa City;

of beginning, containing an area consisting of seventeen and five-tenths (17.5) hectares.

The area described above is hereby excluded from the coverage of the following: Presidential Decree No. 705, otherwise known as the Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines, as amended, more particularly Section 16 thereof, defining the areas needed for forest purposes; Proclamation No. 219 dated July 2, 1967, declaring the entire Province of Palawan as game refuge and bird sanctuary, and the small islands off Palawan as national reserves; and Proclamation No. 2151 dated December 29, 1981, declaring the entire Province of Palawan and certain parcels of the public domain and/or parts of the country as mangrove swamp forest reserves.

SEC. 2. Disposition of the Agricultural Land. – To promote economic development and create livelihood opportunities for the local community, any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) shall alienate the declared

agricultural land described in Section 1 hereof, to qualified applicants in accordance with the pertinent provisions of Commonwealth Act No. 141, otherwise known as the Public Land Act, as amended, and other public land laws, subject to the limitations provided herein.

- SEC. 3. Promotion of Ecological Balance. The DENR shall ensure that any development in the area shall include the promotion of ecological conservation and conform with existing environmental protection laws, rules and regulations. Moreover, the twenty (20)-meter protection zone along the banks of any river or stream, which has a width of at least five (5) meters, shall retain their classification as forestland and shall be surveyed and delineated by the DENR on the ground prior to disposition of any lot to private applicants.
- SEC. 4. Implementing Rules and Regulations. Within three (3) months following the effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of the DENR shall issue the necessary implementing orders, rules and regulations and circulars to implement the provisions of this Act.
- SEC. 5. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the other parts of this Act.
- SEC. 6. Repealing Clause. All laws, acts, presidential decrees, executive orders, administrative orders, rules and regulations and other issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are deemed amended, modified or repealed accordingly.
- SEC. 7. Effectivity Clause. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in any newspaper of general circulation.
