AN ACT REAPPORTIONING THE COMPOSITION OF THE THIRD
(3RD) AND FOURTH (4TH) LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS OF THE
PROVINCE OF BULACAN AND THEREBY CREATING A NEW
LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS THE FIFTH
LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT OF THE PROVINCE OF BULACAN

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The composition of the current Third (3rd) and Fourth (4th)
2 Legislative Districts of the Province of Bulacan is hereby reapportioned in
3 order to create an additional legislative district to be known as the Fifth
4 Legislative District to commence in the next national and local elections after
5 the effectivity of this Act.

6 SEC. 2. The reapportionment described in the preceding section is
7 summarized as follows:

8 (a) Third Legislative District -- The Third Legislative District shall
9 be composed of the municipalities of Angat, Doña Remedios Trinidad,
10 San Ildefonso, San Miguel and San Rafael;

11 (b) Fourth Legislative District -- The Fourth Legislative District shall
12 be composed of the municipalities of Marilao and Obando and the City of
13 Meycauayan; and

1 (c) Fifth Legislative District – The Fifth Legislative District shall be
2 composed of the municipalities of Sta. Maria and Norzagaray.

3 SEC. 3. *Additional Seats in the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.* – The
4 provision of Section 41(b) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the
5 Local Government Code of 1991, as amended by Republic Act No. 8853, to
6 the contrary notwithstanding, there is hereby allocated two (2) additional seats
7 in the sangguniang panlalawigan for the Fifth Legislative District of the
8 Province of Bulacan.

9 SEC. 4. *Incumbent Representatives and Members of the Sangguniang*
10 *Panalalawigan.* – The incumbent Representatives of the Third and Fourth
11 Legislative Districts and the Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of
12 the Province of Bulacan shall continue to represent their respective legislative
13 districts until the new representatives and members of the Sangguniang
14 Panlalawigan shall have been elected and qualified.

15 SEC. 5. *Rules and Regulations.* – The Commission on Elections
16 shall issue the necessary rules and regulations to implement this Act.

17 SEC. 6. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, rules and regulations which
18 are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified
19 accordingly.

20 SEC. 7. *Effectivity Clause.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)
21 days after its publication in any newspaper of general circulation.
