AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE
TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT
AUTHORITY (TESDA) TRAINING AND ACCREDITATION
CENTER IN THE CITY OF SAN JOSE DEL MONTE, BULACAN
AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Short Title.* – This Act shall be known as the “San Jose
2 Del Monte City TESDA Training and Accreditation Center Act of 2012”.

3 SEC. 2. *Establishment.* – There is hereby established the Technical
4 Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) Training and
5 Accreditation Center in the City of San Jose Del Monte, Bulacan under the
6 supervision of the TESDA, hereinafter referred to as the Training and
7 Accreditation Center.

8 SEC. 3. *General Mandate.* – The Training and Accreditation Center
9 shall primarily provide technical and vocational training and skills
10 development programs to low-income families and out-of-school youth in the

1 City of San Jose Del Monte to make them productive, as well as to help them
2 develop into middle-level skilled manpower, so as to hasten the social
3 development of the city and to meet the needs of both local and international
4 markets. It shall also serve as the assessment center for technical and
5 vocational skills in the city.

6 SEC. 4. *Curricular Offerings.* – The Training and Accreditation
7 Center shall offer short-term certificate courses in Shielded Metal Arc
8 Welding; Auto Servicing; Plumbing; Refrigeration and Airconditioning;
9 Building Wiring; Masonry; Commercial Cooking; Housekeeping; Household
10 Management and other technical-vocational courses within its areas of
11 specialization.

12 SEC. 5. *School Site.* – The Training and Accreditation Center shall be
13 built on a two (2)-hectare portion of the National Housing Authority (NHA)
14 property in Barangay San Manuel, City of San Jose Del Monte, Bulacan,
15 which is covered by TCT No. 366649 (M) of the Register of Deeds of
16 Meycauayan, Bulacan, and under usufruct agreement among the NHA, the
17 provincial government of Bulacan and the Office of the Lone Congressional
18 District of San Jose Del Monte, Bulacan.

19 SEC. 6. *Administration.* – The Training and Accreditation Center
20 shall be headed by a Technical Vocational Administrator under the supervision
21 of the TESDA.

22 SEC. 7. *Appropriations.* – The Director General of the TESDA shall
23 include in the TESDA's program the establishment of the TESDA Training
24 and Accreditation Center, the funding of which shall be included in the annual
25 General Appropriations Act. The city government of San Jose Del Monte,
26 Bulacan shall set aside funds from any available local revenues in an amount
27 deemed appropriate by the city officials concerned as subsidy for the
28 operationalization of the Training and Accreditation Center.

1 SEC. 8. *Implementing Rules and Regulations.* – The TESDA, in
2 coordination with the Department of Trade and Industry, shall formulate and
3 issue the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of
4 this Act.

5 SEC. 9. *Separability Clause.* – If, for any reason, any part or provision
6 of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts or
7 provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

8 SEC. 10. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, presidential decrees, executive
9 orders, rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of
10 this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

11 SEC. 11. *Effectivity Clause.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)
12 days after its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
