AN ACT DECLARING THE ISLAND OF MALAPASCUA IN THE PROVINCE OF CEBU AN ECOTOURISM ZONE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. Declaration of Policy. – It is hereby declared the policy 2 of the State to promote a sustainable tourism industry. Towards this end, the 3 country shall rationalize all efforts pertaining to environmental protection and 4 making the tourism industry a major source of livelihood and an avenue for the 5 generation of employment. Henceforth, aggressive measures seeking to restore 6 the country's share in the Asian tourist market shall be undertaken consistent 7 with the preservation of the country's ecosystem and natural environment.

- 8 Pursuant to the above policy, the Island of Malapascua in the Province9 of Cebu is hereby declared an ecotourism zone.
- 10 SEC. 2. Creation of an Ecotourism Task Force. Within one (1) 11 year from the approval of this Act, there shall be created an Ecotourism Task 12 Force whose governing board shall be co-chaired by the Representative of the 13 Fourth District of Cebu and the Governor of Cebu. The membership of the 14 Board shall be composed of representatives from the Department of 15 Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), the Department of Tourism

1 (DOT), the Department of Health (DOH), the private sector, nongovernment 2 organizations, and the local government units concerned. The funding 3 requirements for the operation of the Ecotourism Task Force shall be charged 4 against the funds of the local government unit concerned.

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> 5 SEC. 3. *Ecotourism Master Plan.* – The DENR and the DOT shall 6 prepare an ecotourism master plan for the area and promulgate the necessary 7 rules and regulations to be approved by the President of the Philippines, upon 8 recommendation of the Board, for implementation by the concerned national 9 government agencies and local government units.

SEC. 4. Appropriations. - The Secretary of the DOT shall include in
the Department's program the implementation of the ecotourism master plan,
the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations
Act and/or internally generated funds of the Department.

SEC. 5. Separability Clause. - Any provision of this Act or part
hereof that may be declared unconstitutional shall not affect the effectivity of
the other provisions.

SEC. 6. Repealing Clause. - All laws, executive orders, presidential
decrees, rules and regulations, and other issuances contrary to or inconsistent
with this Act shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 7. Effectivity Clause. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)
days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general
circulation.
