- AN ACT DECLARING DECEMBER 16 OF EVERY YEAR AS THE SENDONG MEMORIAL AND DISASTER PREPAREDNESS DAY IN CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY AND ILIGAN CITY
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
- SECTION 1. It is hereby recognized that Sendong claimed thousands of lives and caused millions worth of damage and that Sendong is only a small taste of what Mother Nature can do to those who abuse the environment.
- SEC. 2. December 16 of every year is hereby declared as the Sendong
 Memorial and Disaster Preparedness Day in Cagayan de Oro City and Iligan
 City.
 - SEC. 3. The following activities shall be undertaken in observance of this occasion:
- 9 (a) The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) 10 shall conduct tree planting/reforestation activities;

(b) The National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council
(NDRRMC) shall conduct forums on disaster and risk reduction in Cagayan de
Oro City;

- (c) The Climate Change Commission (CCC) shall conduct forums on climate change adaptation:
- (d) The Local Government Units (LGUs) of Cagayan de Oro and Higan cities shall convene their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) and undertake seminars to implement disaster risk reduction measures:
- (e) Nongovernmental organizations shall organize information drives/campaigns to increase awareness on disaster awareness, climate change, the effects of abusing the environment, disaster preparedness and disaster readiness; and
- (f) Other activities that would raise awareness like masses, fun runs and photo exhibits.
- SEC. 4. Separability Clause. Should any of the provisions of this Act or any part thereof be declared invalid, the other provisions, so far as they are separable from the invalid ones, shall remain in full force and effect.
- SEC. 5. Repealing Clause. All laws, presidential decrees and issuances, executive orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- 22 SEC. 6. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after 23 its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
