AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKE'S POINT, PROVINCE OF PALAWAN AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established, in the Municipality of Brooke's
Point, Province of Palawan, a district office of the Land Transportation Office
(LTO) which shall exercise jurisdiction over all barangays of the Municipality
of Brooke's Point and the neighboring municipalities of Narra, Sofronio
Española, Bataraza, Quezon, Rizal and the island municipality of Balabac in
the Second Congressional District of the Province of Palawan.

SEC. 2. The LTO office shall be located in an area in the municipality that is accessible to the people.

9 SEC. 3. The head of the LTO office and staff shall be appointed by the Secretary of Transportation and Communications in accordance with existing laws.

1	SEC. 4. The Secretary of Transportation and Communications shall
2	formulate the rules and regulations necessary for the implementation of this
3	Act.
4	SEC. 5. The Secretary of Transportation and Communications shall
5	immediately include in the Department's programs the operationalization of
6	the LTO office in the Municipality of Brooke's Point, Province of Palawan, the
7	funding of which shall be included in the General Appropriations Act.
8	SEC. 6. Separability Clause If, for any reason, any section of this
9	Act shall be deemed unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or
10	provisions of this Act shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in force
11	and effect.
12	SEC. 7. Repealing Clause - All laws, executive orders, decrees,
13	instructions, rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with any
14	provision of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
15	SEC. 8. Effectivity Clause This Act shall take effect immediately
16	upon its approval.
