AN ACT SEPARATING CATARMAN NATIONAL THE SCHOOL – GALUTAN ANNEX IN BARANGAY GALUTAN. MUNICIPALITY OF CATARMAN, PROVINCE OF NORTHERN SAMAR FROM THE CATARMAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL. CONVERTING łТ INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL AGRO-INDUSTRIAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS GALUTAN NATIONAL AGRO-INDUSTRIAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Separation 1 and Conversion National 2 Agro-Industrial High School. - The Catarman National High School -3 Galutan Annex in Barangay Galutan, Municipality of Catarman, Province of Northern Samar is hereby separated from the Catarman National High School 4 5 and converted into an independent national agro-industrial high school to be 6 known as Galutan National Agro-Industrial High School. 7 SEC. 2. Transfer of Assets and Liabilities. - All personnel, assets,
  - liabilities and records of the Catarman National High School Galutan Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Galutan National Agro-Industrial High School.
