AN ACT ESTABLISHING ESTATE SETTLEMENT COURTS, GRANTING THEM ORIGINAL JURISDICTION OVER CASES FOR SETTLEMENT OF ESTATE OF DECEASED PERSONS, AMENDING BATAS PAMBANSA BLG. 129, AS AMENDED
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled.  Section 1. This Act shall be known as the "Estate Settlement Court
Act".
SEC. 2. The State recognizes the need for the speedy disposition of
estate settlement cases so that the property may be immediately released to
commercial circulation and made available for business transaction, thus
generating further subjects of taxation and stimulating economic activity.
SEC. 3. There shall be established, by way of designation of a Regional
Trial Court branch, an Estate Settlement Court in every province and highly
urbanized city in the country.

1	SEC. 4. The Estate Settlement Court shall exercise original jurisdiction
2	to hear and decide all cases of settlement of estate of deceased persons,
3	regardless of the gross value of the estate.
4	SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the
5	Supreme Court shall promulgate the necessary rules for its implementation, to
6	include the designation of and the transfer of cases thereto.
7	SEC. 6. All other laws inconsistent herewith arc hereby repealed,
8	amended or modified accordingly.
9	SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
10	in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
	Approved,
