AN ACT DECLARING THE TWIN LAKES OF BALINSASAYAO AND DANAO LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SIBULAN, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL NEGROS AS AN ECO-TOURISM SPOT, PROVIDING FOR ITS DEVELOPMENT AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Twin Lakes of Balinsasayao and Danao in the Municipality of Sibulan, Province of Oriental Negros is hereby declared an eco-tourism spot. As such, it shall be accorded priority development by the Department of Tourism (DOT) and shall be subject to the rules and regulations governing the development of eco-tourism spots.

SEC. 2. The DOT, in coordination with the local government of Sibulan, the Representative of the Second Congressional District of Oriental Negros and other concerned agencies of the government shall, within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, prepare a development plan involving the construction, installation and maintenance of such appropriate facilities and infrastructure as shall enhance eco-tourism in the area: *Provided*, That said development plan shall ensure the preservation and conservation of the natural resources of the area.

	SEC. 3.	The DO	Γ shall	take	immediate	steps i	in implem	enting	the
tourism development plan that will suit the natural characteristic of the Twin									
Lakes and shall incorporate the same in its overall development plans and									
programs for national implementation.									

- SEC. 4. It shall also be the responsibility of the DOT to promote the Twin Lakes as an eco-tourism spot in all its national, regional and local promotion programs.
- SEC. 5. The DOT shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for proper implementation of this Act.
- SEC. 6. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be charged against the internally generated funds of the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) and/or the appropriations in the annual General Appropriations Act.
- SEC. 7. All laws, rules, regulations, proclamations, executive orders or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby amended accordingly.
 - SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
