AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR A MALE FOREIGNER DESIRING TO MARRY A FILIPINA AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE ARTICLE 21 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 209, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE FAMILY CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Article 21 of Executive Order No. 209, as amended, otherwise known as "The Family Code of the Philippines", is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"ART. 21. When either or both of the contracting parties are citizens of a foreign country, it shall be necessary for them before a marriage license can be obtained, to submit a certificate of legal capacity to contract marriage, issued by their respective diplomatic or consular officials. WHEN THE MALE CONTRACTING PARTY IS A FOREIGNER, IN ADDITION TO THE CERTIFICATE OF LEGAL CAPACITY, A CERTIFICATE OF GOOD

01	SEC. 2. The Department of Justice, in coordination with the					
11	Department of Foreign Affairs, the Department of Social Welfare and					
12	Development, the Department of the Interior and Local Government, the					
13	Philippine Commission on Women, the Commission on Filipinos Overseas					
4	and the Philippine Statistics Authority shall promulgate the rules and					
15	regulations necessary for the implementation of this Act within ninety (90)					
16	days from approval thereof.					
17	SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication					
8	in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
