



AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
TANYAG IN THE CITY OF TAGUIG, METRO MANILA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Tanyag.* – Tanyag Proper in
2 Barangay Bagong Tanyag, City of Taguig, Metro Manila is hereby separated
3 from Barangay Bagong Tanyag and constituted into a distinct and independent
4 barangay to be known as Barangay Tanyag.

5 SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries of
6 Barangay Tanyag shall consist of permanent natural boundaries identified as
7 follows:

8 “Bounded on the North by Mafalac Avenue;

9 On the East by Manila Railroad Company (Railroad Tract);

10 On the South by lots 8019, 8018, 8025 Case 15 Meadm 590-D Taguig
11 Cadastral Mapping; and

12 On the West by North Daang Hari Road and Parañaque Cadastre.”

13 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite
14 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in

1 Barangay Bagong Tanyag pursuant to City Ordinance No. 25, Series of 2008
2 of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the
3 creation of Barangay Tanyag as proclaimed by the City Board of Canvassers
4 on December 28, 2008 shall serve as substantial compliance with the
5 plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
6 amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

7 **SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.*** – The incumbent barangay
8 officials of Barangay Tanyag, City of Taguig shall continue to hold office until
9 such time that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

10 **SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructures and Facilities.*** – All existing public
11 infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
12 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
13 and shall be administered by the new barangay.

14 **SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.*** – Barangay Tanyag shall
15 be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section
16 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the "Local
17 Government Code of 1991".

18 **SEC. 7. *Separability Clause.*** – If, for any reason, any part or
19 provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or
20 provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full
21 force and effect.

22 **SEC. 8. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
23 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general
24 circulation.
