9	SEC. 3. Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite The plebiscite
10	conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in
11	Barangay Hagonoy pursuant to City Ordinance No. 24, Series of 2008 of the
12	Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the creation of
13	Barangay San Miguel as proclaimed by the City Board of Canvassers on
14	December 28, 2008, shall serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite
15	requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended,
16	otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".
17	SEC. 4. Incumbent Barangay Officials The incumbent barangay
18	officials of Barangay San Miguel, City of Taguig, Metro Manila shall continue
19	to hold office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and
20	qualified.
21	SEC. 5. Public Infrastructures and Facilities All existing public
22	infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
23	approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
24	and shall be administered by the new barangay.
25	SEC. 6. Internal Revenue Allotment Shares Barangay San Miguel
26	shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to
27	Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
28	"Local Government Code of 1991".

1	SEC. 7. Separability Clause If, for any reason, any part or provision
2	of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or provisions
3	which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.
4	SEC. 8. Effectivity This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
5	its publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general
5	circulation.
