AN ACT DECLARING THE TAGNOTE FALLS -- MT. HILONG-HILONG
PARK LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF REMEDIOS T.
ROMUALDEZ, PROVINCE OF AGUSAN DEL NORTE AS A
TOURISM DEVELOPMENT SITE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS
THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled

SECTION 1. The Tagnote Falls – Mt. Hilong-Hilong Park located in the Municipality of Remedios T. Romualdez, Province of Agusan del Norte is hereby declared a tourism development site. As such, the Department of Tourism (DOT) is mandated to incorporate it in the Philippine National Tourism Development Plan.

SEC. 2. The DOT, in coordination with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) and the provincial and municipal local government units concerned, shall, within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, prepare a tourism development plan for the area that is cognizant of its environmental and social significance, and undertake the implementation of the said plan.

SEC. 3. The DOT, in coordination with the provincial and municipal
local government units concerned, shall issue rules and regulations as it may
deem necessary for the implementation of this Act.
SEC. 4. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's
program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included
in the annual General Appropriations Act and/or internally generated funds of
the Department.
SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
