AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE CONCEPCION DISTRICT HOSPITAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CONCEPCION, PROVINCE OF TARLAC TO CORAZON C. AQUINO MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, INCREASING ITS BED CAPACITY FROM FIFTY (50) TO ONE HUNDRED (100) BEDS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The name of the Concepcion District Hospital in the
Municipality of Concepcion, Province of Tarlac is hereby changed to Corazon
C. Aquino Memorial Hospital.

SEC. 2. The authorized bed capacity of the Corazon C. Aquino
Memorial Hospital is hereby increased from fifty (50) to one hundred (100)
beds.

SEC. 3. The existing hospital facilities and professional health care services of the Corazon C. Aquino Memorial Hospital are hereby upgraded and increased to commensurate with the increase in bed capacity. The number of medical personnel shall be correspondingly increased. The Department of Health, in coordination with the Department of Budget and Management and

1	the Corazon C.	Aquino	Memorial	Hospital,	shall	determine	the	additional
2	plantilla positions to be created pursuant to this Act.							

- SEC. 4. The increase in bed capacity of the Corazon C. Aquino Memorial Hospital from fifty (50) to one hundred (100) beds shall be implemented within the period of not more than two (2) years from the approval of this Act.
- SEC. 5. The Provincial Government of Tarlac shall provide funding for the increase in bed capacity of Corazon C. Aquino Memorial Hospital in the Municipality of Concepcion, Province of Tarlac. The Secretary of Health shall include in the Department's program, subsidy support for the capital outlay requirements of the said hospital.
- 12 SEC. 6. Republic Act No. 7224 is hereby repealed. All laws, issuances 13 or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified 14 accordingly.
 - SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
