



## HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

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BY REPRESENTATIVE GARCIA-ALBANO, PER COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 572

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AN ACT DIVIDING BARANGAY PAMPANGA IN THE CITY OF DAVAO INTO THREE (3) DISTINCT AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAYS TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY PAMPANGA, BARANGAY ALFONSO ANGLIONGTO, SR. AND BARANGAY V. HIZON

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. *Division of Barangay Pampanga.* – Barangay Pampanga  
2 in the City of Davao is hereby divided into three (3) distinct and independent  
3 barangays to be known as: (1) Barangay Pampanga; (2) Barangay Alfonso  
4 Angliongto, Sr.; and (3) Barangay V. Hizon.

5           SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries of each  
6 barangay created in the immediately preceding section shall be as follows:

7           (1) Barangay Pampanga

8           “Bounded on the North by the Davao International Airport Runway;

9           On the West by Barangay Vicente Hizon, Sr.;

10          On the South by the coastline of the Davao Gulf; and

11          On the West by Barangay Sasa, Doña Pilar Road and Rodriguez Drive  
12 comprising of Doña Asuncion I, Doña Asuncion II, San Roque, Don Lorenzo,  
13 Sto. Domingo II, D.A. Homes and COACO Beach”;

1 (2) Barangay Alfonso Angliongto, Sr.

2 "Bounded on the Northwest by Belisario Road, Belisario Fence, Te  
3 Property and NHA Buhangin;

4 On the North by Barangay Cabantian and Phases 1 and 3 of La Verna  
5 Subdivision;

6 On the West by Carmelite Road;

7 On the South by J.P. Laurel Avenue; and

8 On the East by Nova Tierra Village, Fortune Homes and Insular Village  
9 Phase 1 comprising of La Verna Subdivision Phase 2, Diamond Village Phases  
10 1 and 2, Belisario Subdivision, Saint Anthony Village, Mamay Village,  
11 Vincent Heights, Roseville, Lea Subdivision, Guadalupe Village, Summer Hill,  
12 Pulang Lupa, Liceralde Subdivision, Golden Homes, JLA Subdivision, and  
13 Victoria Heights Subdivision";

14 (3) Barangay V. Hizon

15 "Bounded on the North by the Davao International Airport Runway;

16 On the West by Barangay Alfonso Angliongto, Sr. and Barangay  
17 Lapu-Lapu;

18 On the South by the coastline of the Davao Gulf;

19 On the Southeast by J.P. Laurel Avenue (a.k.a. Davao-Agusan Road)  
20 and the Insular Creek;

21 On the East by Doña Asuncion Road; and

22 On the Northeast by Doña Asuncion comprising of Insular Village I,  
23 Insular Village II, Fortune Executive Homes, Nova Tierra Village, PEHA  
24 Subdivision, PEHO, Belen Homes, Sto. Domingo I, Donas Ville, Model  
25 Homes, Lizada, Beach Club and Mountain Dew".

26 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite  
27 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in  
28 Barangay Pampanga pursuant to City Ordinance No. 00161-03 of the

1 Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Davao, which ratified the creation of  
2 Barangay Alfonso Angliongto, Sr. and of Barangay V. Hizon as proclaimed by  
3 the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on July 25, 2004, shall serve as substantial  
4 compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act  
5 No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of  
6 1991”.

7         SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent barangay  
8 officials of Barangays Pampanga, Alfonso Angliongto, Sr. and V. Hizon, City  
9 of Davao shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors have  
10 been duly elected and qualified.

11         SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructures and Facilities.* – All existing public  
12 infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the  
13 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and  
14 shall be administered by the new barangays.

15         SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangays Pampanga,  
16 Alfonso Angliongto, Sr. and V. Hizon shall be entitled to Internal Revenue  
17 Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as  
18 amended, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”.

19         SEC. 7. *Separability Clause.* – If, for any reason, any part or provision  
20 of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or provisions  
21 which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

22         SEC. 8. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
23 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
