## AN ACT GRANTING PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS FREE ADMISSION TO ALL PUBLIC MUSEUMS AND NATIONAL HISTORICAL SHRINES AND LANDMARKS

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. All public elementary school students are hereby granted 2 free admission to all public museums and national historical shrines and 3 landmarks, subject to capacity and availability as determined by the National 4 Museum or the National Historical Commission of the Philippines. 5

SEC. 2. Within ninety (90) days from the approval of this Act, the National Museum and the National Historical Commission of the Philippines, in coordination with the Department of Education, shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
