AN ACT DECLARING THE SHRINE OF THE BATTLE OF PULANG
LUPA AND ITS PREMISES LOCATED IN BARANGAY POCTOY,
MUNICIPALITY OF TORRIJOS, PROVINCE OF MARINDUQUE
A HISTORICAL PARK AND ECOTOURISM SITE AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Shrine of the Battle of Pulang Lupa and its premises located in Barangay Poctoy, Municipality of Torrijos, Province of Marinduque is hereby declared a historical park and ecotourism site. As such, its development shall be prioritized by the Department of Tourism (DOT) and other concerned agencies, subject to the rules and regulations governing the development of ecotourism sites.

SEC. 2. The DOT, in coordination with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority and other concerned agencies of government, shall, within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, prepare the development plan involving the construction, installation and/or maintenance of such appropriate facilities which shall enhance tourism in the area: *Provided*, That said

- SEC. 3. The DOT shall take immediate steps to implement said development plan and incorporate the same in the Department's overall tourism development program for the ensuing calendar year.
- 6 SEC. 4. The DOT shall likewise promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the proper implementation of this Act.
  - SEC. 5. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act and internally generated funds of the DOT.
- 12 SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication 13 in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
