AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MULTIPURPOSE FISHERY BREEDING FARM AND HATCHERY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF QUEZON, PROVINCE OF QUEZON AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources of the Department of Agriculture (BFAR-DA), a multipurpose fishery breeding farm and hatchery in the Municipality of Quezon, Province of Quezon.
- SEC. 2. The BFAR-DA shall conduct continuing research and experimentation, especially as they apply to local conditions, to discover new methods and technology that will rejuvenate the fishing industry.
- SEC. 3. The Secretary of Agriculture shall include in the Department's programs the establishment of a multipurpose fishery breeding farm and hatchery in the Municipality of Quezon, Province of Quezon, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. The local government units concerned shall set aside funds from any available local revenue in an amount deemed appropriate for their operationalization.

1	SEC. 4. The Department of Agriculture and its related agencies shall
2	promulgate the necessary rules and regulations to implement this Act.
3	SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
4	in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
